NOTICE OF RACE

This regatta will be organized by the King Harbor Youth Foundation and King Harbor Yacht Club.

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and “Conditions for USODA Events” which can be found at www.usoda.org/.
- 1.2. The “class rules” for the purposes of the definition of “rules” are the International Optimist Association Class Rules.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. International Optimist Dinghies may enter by completing registration, paying all entry fees, and completing all measurement requirements.
- 2.2. The Red, Blue and White Fleet assignments will be based on the competitor’s age on the first day of the regatta.

3. Registration; Entry Fees

Registration must be completed online at KHYC.org or KHYF.org. The entry fee will be \$50 - includes a regatta T-shirt and dinner Saturday night. *A \$10 late fee will be applied to all participants that enter after April 21.*

4. Format of the Regatta

- 4.1. There will be a Championship fleet and a Green fleet.
- 4.2. The race committee will run as many sets of races or races as practical. If 6 or more races are completed, a sailor’s worst score will be dropped.

6. Sailing Instructions

Preliminary sailing Instructions may be available online, and final official sailing instructions will be available onsite at check-in.

7. Venue

The Championship Fleet racing area will be approximately .5 miles south of the King Harbor Marina. The Green Fleet will sail in the turning basin, at the south end of the King Harbor Marina.

8. Safety and Adult Responsibility

- 8.1. All sailors and support boats shall wear a US Coast Guard certified PFD at all times while on the water.
- 8.2. An adult (Parent, guardian or designated adult) is responsible for the safety of the each sailor. It is the responsibility solely of this adult to decide if the sailor should sail in the weather and sea conditions that might arise during the event. The adults supervising the competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks.
- 8.3. Parents not personally attending any part of the event shall ensure that another adult is authorized and designated to make these decisions for their sailor, and each competitor shall indicate in writing the parent or adult representative that will be responsible for the competitor throughout the event.
- 8.4. *The designated adult shall accept full responsibility for all actions of the competitor during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.*

9. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. All competitors and their parent/guardian shall sign a waiver.

10. Hospitality

Dinner Saturday evening will be open to all family and friends for an additional fee of \$10 per child (15 & under) and \$15 per adult. There will be a raffle following dinner.

KHYC Galley will be open for breakfast and lunch, Saturday and Sunday

11. GoPro Raffle

A GoPro Hero3 Black Edition will be raffled Saturday evening, following dinner. Raffle tickets will be available \$5 each, at registration and throughout the day, on Saturday.
