NOTICE OF RACE

DRYC and SMWYC invite all sailors to participate in the "Regatta for Hope." All donations go to City of Hope and may be tax deductible. Racers and Cruisers are encouraged to sail in this event and to invite family and guests for the adventure. Membership in a recognized Yacht Club is not a requirement for this Regatta. Boats without a PHRF Certificate will be entered in the Cruising Class.

The Regatta for Hope is designed as a fun race with elements of a slalom course with multiple marks and for both Racer and Cruiser/Novice classes. Boats may be asked to display a sponsor's banner.

RULES – The race will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*. The Organizing Authority for this Regatta is Del Rey Yacht Club.

ENTRIES – A suggested minimum donation of \$35.00 from the skipper and for each crew member. No additional entry fee.

The cutoff time for entries is Saturday, May 17, 2014 at 1800 hours. Late entries may be accepted with the approval of the regatta chair.

All entries (not fees) must be submitted on line at U.S. Sailing's Regatta Network.
There will be no race entry fees accepted online.

The procedure to enter the race is:

1. Click [HERE](#) to complete the Allowances Form (Catalina 42 & Cruiser classes only),
2. Register on [Regatta Network](#) (using the calculated rating from the Allowance Form),
3. Make Donation on the [City of Hope page](#).

Cruisers should have a cruising handicap assigned and approved by the DRYC Cruising Chairman the Wednesday (4 days) prior to the race. The Cruiser Handicap **Worksheet is available on line click [HERE](#). This form must be submitted to the DRYC Race Committee: regattaforhope2014@gmail.com, Fax (310) 821-1346, or in person at DRYC Front Office.**

STARTS – 1st Warning Signal will be at 1255 hours at SS mark in the Marina del Rey Racing Circle. This will be a pursuit race (INVERTED START).

NOTICES – Sailing Instructions, start times, courses, signals, classes and any notices will be available on Sunday, May 18 at the "[Mandatory Skippers Meeting](#)" at DRYC. The meeting starts at 1000 hours. This meeting is also your official Check-in for the race.

Sailing Instructions will be available at the DRYC web site and Regatta Network the Friday prior to the race at 1800 hours. **Times for the Inverted Start Sequence will be given out at the Skippers meeting.**

PROTESTS – Will be heard on Tuesday, May 20, at 1900 hours in the DRYC Club.

TROPHIES – The boat raising the most money for City of Hope (by 1000 hours race day) will be awarded the Lois Yudovin Perpetual Trophy. Class trophies will be awarded for each class based upon entries.

TROPHY PRESENTATION and AFTER-PARTY - All racers, family and friends are invited to take part in the Trophy Presentations and the After-Race Hospitality in the DRYC Bar area (non-host) and event Party.
