

# 2014 COMMODORE'S REGATTA APRIL 5, 2014

#### 1 Rules

- 1.1 The series will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Rule 40 will be changed to require competitors to wear a personal flotation device while racing. Changes to the rules will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may change other rules

### 2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 This series is open to all boat holding a valid 2014 Monterey Bay PHRF certificate.
- There will be a Double Handed division and the following PHRF divisions: A fleet (88 or less), B Fleet (greater than 88), Jib & Main (181 or less) and Jib & Main (greater than 181). PHRF divisions shall have a minimum of two persons on board. Double Handed division shall have exactly two persons on board with a minimum of two crew between 10 and 70 years old and unlimited crew younger than 10 or older than 70.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at <a href="http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/7979">http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/7979</a> or <a href="scyc.org">scyc.org</a> and only on-line entries will be accepted.

#### 3 Fees

- 3.1 The early entry fee is \$40.00 and is applicable if entry is completed by 2000 hours on Wednesday, April 2, 2014.
- 3.2 The regular entry fee of \$60.00 is applied to all entries received after 1100 hours on Saturday, April 5, 2014.
- 3.3 Registration closes at 1100 hours on Saturday, April 5, 2014.
- 3.4 All entry fees are nonrefundable.

#### 4 Schedules

- 4.1 A competitors' briefing is scheduled for 1100 hours on Saturday, April 5, 2014 at the SCYC clubhouse.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1255 hours each race day.
- 4.3 One race will be scheduled.
- 4.5 An awards ceremony will be held after racing at the SCYC clubhouse.

### **5 Sailing Instructions**

5.1 The sailing instructions will be available at the competitors' meeting and online. Courses will be distributed with the sailing instructions.

#### 6 Venues


Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys or fixed buoys in the area bounded by Moss Landing to the southeast, Davenport to the northwest and extending up to five miles off shore.

#### 7 Prizes

7.1 Prizes will be awarded to each division for first place and additional places based upon the number of entries at the discretion of the organizing authority.

#### 8. Course

8.1 The course will appear in the sailing instructions. The race will be a pursuit race with boats starting at a time determined by their handicap from the largest handicap starting first to the smallest. The start time of each boat will be available at the competitors' briefing.

By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
