8 VENUE

8.1 St. Thomas Yacht Club at Cowpet Bay and surrounding waters.

9 THE COURSES

For Fleet Racing:

The courses to be sailed will be as follows: Modified Trapezoid or Windward / Leeward. If conditions warrant, the courses will be modified to accommodate the appropriate wind conditions. Green fleet will receive their course at the skipper's meeting each morning.

For Team Racing:

For the team racing championships the course will be a starboard "S" course.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1 For Green Fleet sailors, rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 10.2 Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

11 SCORING

- 11.1 One completed race constitutes a series.
- 11.2 (a) When less than six races have been completed; a boat's series score will be the total of all of her race scores.

(b) When six or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12 SUPPORT/SAFETY/COACH BOATS

There will be a mandatory meeting for all non-race committee boats on May 3, 2014 at 0900. Failure to attend could be reflected in your sailor/team results.

13 PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded to the top two in the Red, Blue and White classes and top three overall as well as the top place female. Participation awards will be awarded to all green fleet sailors.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15 CHARTER BOATS

Complete Charter Boats are available at \$55 per day or \$150 for the event. Sailors must bring their own sail.
