

2014 MOORE 24 REGATTA APRIL 26 - 27, 2014

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The rules of the Moore24 Class will apply.
- 1.3 Rule 40 will be changed to require competitors to wear personal flotation while racing.
- 1.4 Rule 44.1 will be changed replacing Two Turns Penalty with a One Turn Penalty. Changes to the rules will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may change other rules.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 All Moore 24 Class boats are eligible to participate in this regatta.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/8048 or scyc.org. Only on-line entries will be accepted.

3 Fees

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$70.00 if received by Wednesday, April 23, 2014.
- 3.2 A late entry fee of \$90.00 is applied to all entries received after Wednesday, April 23, 2014.
- 3.3 Registration closes at 1000 hours on Saturday, April 26, 2014.
- 3.4 All entry fees are nonrefundable.

4 Schedules

- 4.1 A competitors' meeting is scheduled for 1030 hours on Saturday, April 26, 2014 at the SCYC clubhouse.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal on Saturday is 1225 hours.
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the first warning signal on Sunday is 1200 hours. No warning signal will be made after 1530 hours Sunday.
- 4.3 Six (6) races are scheduled for the regatta with three (3) races each race day.
- 4.5 Three (3) races will constitute a regatta.
- 4.6 There will be an awards ceremony at the SCYC clubhouse on Sunday, April 27, 2014 following racing.

5 Sailing Instructions

5.1 The sailing instructions will be available at the competitors' meeting and may be posted on line at scyc.org.

6 Venues

Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys in the north end of Monterey Bay in an area approximately 3 miles radius from the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty. Windward-leeward, triangle-windward-leeward temporary-buoy courses and ocean courses may be used.

7 Courses

7.1 A course diagram will be provided in the sailing instructions.

8 Scoring

When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's regatta score will be the total of her race scores. When five or more races have been completed, a boat's regatta score will be the total of her scores excluding her worst score.

9 Prizes

9.1 Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority and Moore 24 Class Association.
