- 1. **RULES:** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. Life jackets and shoes are required for each sailor. Shoes must be worn while launching and recovering boats. Life jackets shall be worn while on the water, other than for brief periods while adding or removing clothing.
- 2. CLASSES: The D-12 Regatta is open to all boats of the Laser class (Full, Radial and 4.7 Rigs).

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- · Participants must be members of the International Laser Class Association (ILCA) in order to be scored in the D-12 Championship Series.
- · Eligible boats may enter by completing the Entry Form and paying the required fees to BYSC prior to the regatta.

- · Complete the attached Entry Form and send, along with the fees, to BYSC.
- · Complete the Entry Form and pay the fees the day of the regatta on site.

Advanced registration with appropriate fees must be received by April 25, 2014 to avoid the \$15 late fee.

5. SCHEDULE

11 am Skipper's meeting

12:30 am First Warning signal, more race to follow. 7 pm Happy de-rigging hour – time approximate

7:30 pm Dinner – time approximate

Sunday, May 4

10 am First Warning signal., more races to follow.

No race sequence will be started after 2 pm

Awards presented after racing

6. **MEASUREMENT:**

Sail measurement may be required. Each sail must have the sail number confirmed at Registration. Make sure your number is applied in accordance with ILCA rules. Numbers drawn or colored on sails are not valid. Refer to www.laserinternational.org/sailnops.htm for detailed instructions.

- 7. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** available at check-in
- **8. COURSES** diagramed in Sailing Instructions
- **9. SCORING:** Eight (8) races are scheduled. One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta. After six (6) races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding here worst score. This changes rule A-2.
- **10. PRIZES:** Trophies will be awarded based on number of participants as follows: Top 5 in the Laser Full Rig, plus Top Junior, Top Woman and Top Master. In the Laser Radial: Top Woman and Top Junior. In the 4.7: Top Finisher.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority and the Beaufort Yacht & Sailing Club will not accept any responsibility for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. LODGING

Camping is available on the BYSC grounds with electrical hookups and bathhouse showers. No pets are allowed. 13. DIRECTIONS TO BYSC

From the north: take US 21 to US 21 Business to downtown Beaufort. Cross over the Beaufort River on the Woods swing bridge and take the second right onto Meridian Road. After approximately one mile, turn right on Yacht Club Drive to BYSC. From the south on SC 170: turn right on SC 128 after crossing the Broad River and follow it through Port Royal. Turn right on SC 802 at Hardees, CVS and Advanced Auto Parts. Cross over the Beaufort River and take the first left on Meridian Road. After approximately one mile turn left on Yacht Club Drive to BYSC.
