





2014 ETYSA Regatta Blackbeard Sailing Club April 26-27, 2014 Notice of Race

Blackbeard Sailing Club (BSC), Organizing Authority of the 2014 ETYSA Regatta, sponsored by Soundbank, cordially invites all monohull sailboats with a valid NCPHRF Rating Certificate to join us for racing on the Neuse River near Upper Broad Creek. This regatta is part of the ICRC Team Racing Series.

- 1. The ETYSA Regatta will be held April 26-27 at or near Blackbeard Sailing Club, 1215 Barkentine Drive, New Bern, NC 28560
- 2. The race will be governed by the *<u>The Racing Rules of Sailing</u>*.
- 3. The *Sailing Instructions* will be available at the <u>event website</u> at least one week prior to the event. Please print the instructions and bring them with you to the regatta. A limited number of copies will be available at the skippers meeting.
- 4. This race is open to monohull boats with a valid NCPHRF rating certificate
- 5. Classes are expected to be Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker and cruising as defined by the ICRC. Each class can be further divided into divisions based on rating ranges and number of entries.
- 6. The scoring will be PHRF time on time.
- 7. The courses will be around buoys and government marks, including windward, leeward or reaching marks.
- 8. Scoring will be changed to include Appendix T change T1
- 9. The regatta schedule will be:
 - a. Skippers meeting at 9:00 Saturday, April 26
 - b. First start on Saturday is 11:00
 - c. First start on Sunday is 10:00
 - d. Social directly after racing at BSC on Saturday
 - e. Awards will be promptly at 2:00 on Sunday
- 10. There will be a limited number of free slips available at BSC. Please contact Eddy Parker at eddy52257@yahoo.com to request a slip. Please include length, beam and draft with your request.
- 11. Race entry will be \$50. There is an early bird discount of \$10 for boats registering prior to April 20, 2014.
- Registration will be online at the <u>event website</u>. Late registration will be available Until 09:30 on t April 26. No registrations will be accepted after that point. Skippers meeting will be at 9:00 April 26.
- 13. There will be a social at BSC immediately after racing on Saturday, April 26. The club will serve Burgers, Bratwurst, Potato Salad, Beans and a limited amount of adult beverages. You can order your meal tickets with your boat entry or charge it to your BSC account. A limited number of meals will be available on the day of the event. If you don't let us know that you will attend ahead of time, you will be served after all that did! Meals are \$10 in advance and \$12on the day of the regatta.
