Eligibility: The regatta is open to any boat in the following classes:

J/22 J/105 Etchells J/30 J/35 J/70

Each class must have a minimum entry of 6 boats by Tuesday, 22 April 2014. Each boat shall be insured with valid, third-party liability insurance with a minimum

coverage of \$300,000 USD per event or the equivalent.

Rendezvous: At 1000 in the vicinity of Annapolis Area Mark "X", then proceed to starting area.

Boats should monitor VHF 72 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee. Radio:

Start: First warning signal will be at 1045. No warning signal will be made after 1600.

Schedule: On Saturday, five races are scheduled for all classes. On Sunday, three races are

scheduled for the Etchells class only.

Course: Drop-mark courses as shown in the AYC Event Sailing Instructions.

Rules: This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing

> 2013-2016 (RRS). RRS 63.7, Conflict between Rules, will be replaced by, "If there is a conflict between the Event Sailing Instructions and the Notice Of Race, the Event

Sailing Instructions shall apply."

Event Sailing Instructions will be available online and at the AYC Clubhouse two weeks

prior to the event. All rules changes will be stated in full in the sailing instructions.

The Low Point System in RRS Appendix A will apply, except each boat's series score Scoring:

shall be the total of all of her race scores. One completed race shall constitute a series.

Protests will be heard as soon as possible after racing. US/RRS Appendix T Section B, **Protests:**

Post-Race Penalties, and Section D, Arbitration, will apply.

1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class. Trophies will be presented following racing. Awards:
