

NOTICE OF RACE (03-26-2014)

1. RULES

- 1.1. This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2. US Sailing prescriptions to RRS 60, 63.2 and 63.4 will not apply.
- 1.3. US Sailing prescription Appendix T, Sections A and C will apply.
- 1.4. RRS 63.7 will be replaced by: "If there is a conflict between a rule in the notice of race and one in the sailing instructions, the sailing instructions shall apply."
- 1.5. The rules and policies of Edgewater Yacht Club (EWYC) apply to all participants and their crew members.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. This event is open to members of US Sailing or other National Authorities, members of recognized yacht clubs, members of recognized sailing class associations, and others as may be designated by the Organizing Authority (OA) who are (or will be at the time of the first race) paid members of at least one Edgewater Yacht Club racing fleet.
- 2.2. Eligible boats shall register using online registration or by mailing the completed entry form together with all fees and supporting documentation, including a completed waiver of liability, and valid rating and measurement certificates, in time to arrive prior to the specified deadlines.
 - Online registration is available at <u>www.regattanetwork.com</u>, and mail-in forms are available at the Edgewater Yacht Club office.
 - Competitors not registering online shall either hand in their completed registration to the Edgewater Yacht Club Office during business hours, or mail the registration to: Fleet Captain, Edgewater Yacht Club, 6700 Memorial Parkway NW, Cleveland OH 44102.
 - Deadlines for receipt of registration is 17:00, May 20th, 2014.
- 2.3. The acceptance of registrations received after the specified deadline is at the discretion of the Organizing Authority and, if accepted, shall be subject to a \$50 late fee.
- 2.4. All boats competing shall have the owner or an owner's representative aboard for each race.

3. FEES

- 3.1. The entry fee is \$215 for members of Edgewater Yacht Club. For all other registrations, the entry fee is \$265. Registrants who are not members of US Sailing will be assessed a \$10 surcharge.
- 3.2. First time registrants will be assessed a one-time "Capital Equipment" fee of \$125 to assist with the purchase and maintenance of Race Management equipment.
- 3.3. Fees for membership in Edgewater Yacht Club racing fleets are at the discretion of those fleets and any dues assessed must be paid directly to the fleet. A list of fleets and contact information is available at <u>www.eycweb.com</u> or in the Club Roster.
- 3.4. Boats registered with CYC, FCYC, LYC, MHYC racing programs with paid entry into that Clubs Racing program shall be allowed to enter Edgewater YC race series as a "guest racer" without charge.

4. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 4.1. Races are scheduled on Wednesday evenings and Sunday mornings from May 18th to September 28th, 2014.
- 4.2. A complete schedule of races, including days on which races will not take place is attached as "Exhibit A" and will be posted on the official notice board.
- 4.3. Changes to the schedule of races, including cancellation of races, will be posted on the official notice board no later than 48 hours prior to the date(s) affected.
- 4.4. The time of the first warning signal for each course will be as follows:

5. MEASUREMENT

- 5.1. Each boat shall conform to its class rules.
- 5.2. Possession of a current, valid rating and/or measurement certificate is encouraged and strongly recommended. Fleets may alter ratings and impose rating or other penalties as they deem appropriate.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. Race Packets, including the Sailing Instructions (SI), will be available before the first race at <u>www.regattanetwork.com</u>, <u>www.eycweb.com</u>, or from the Edgewater Yacht Club office.

7. VENUE

7.1. All racing will take place on the open waters of Lake Erie, north of the western entrance to Cleveland Harbor.

8. COURSES

- 8.1. The fixed mark course fleets shall sail courses as defined each race day by the Race Committee (RC), in consultation with the Fleet Captains that will include a combination of Windward/Leeward, Triangle, and Random Leg courses utilizing the EWYC "Compass Rose" marks, other EWYC Fixed Marks, and other fixed location navigational marks and features.
- 8.2. The drop mark course fleets shall sail Windward/Leeward courses as set by the Race Committee each race day.

9. SCORING

- 9.1. "Raw" official scores for all races will be posted on the Regatta page at <u>www.regattanetwork.com</u> by the Edgewater Yacht Club Scoring Committee using the Appendix A "Low-Point" system without excluding a boat's worst score. This changes Rule A2.
- 9.2. "Final" scoring for the series, and the scoring system used to award fleet prizes is at the discretion of each fleet and shall be based on the raw scores as input by the Scoring Committee. This changes Rule 90.3.

10. AWARDS

- 10.1. Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the individual fleets.
- 10.2. Perpetual awards and Overall awards will be presented by EWYC at the Fleet Awards Dinner to be held the evening on November 8th, 2014.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 11.1. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
- 11.2. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

12. INSURANCE

- 12.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid, third-party insurance, sufficient to cover liability for loss, damage, personal injury, or death, with a minimum value of \$100,000.
- 12.2. Each boat shall file evidence of current insurance with the EWYC Office.
