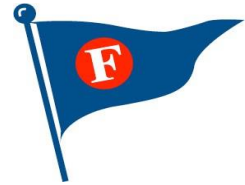




BLACK ROCK HARBOR SINGLE/DOUBLE HAND SERIES



NOTICE OF RACE

June 8, 2104 – July 13, 2014 -August 3, 2104

**Organized by Black Rock Y.C. and Fayerweather Y.C.
Black Rock, Connecticut**

1 Rules

The races will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) 2013-2016, and the current PHRF Regulations as adopted and amended by the YRA of LIS.

2 Eligibility and Entry

2.1 Any sailboat, from any port may compete, but must have a valid 2014 YRA of LIS PHRF certificate, to be eligible for prizes.

2.2 All boats must enter the Series online at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/8285>

2.3 Crew weight limits, and crew weight credits will not apply.

2.4 PHRF ratings issued by the YRA of LIS will be used for scoring.

3 Schedule

3.1 The Series is scheduled for one race June 8, July 13, and August 3, 2013.

3.2 The first warning signal is scheduled for 1300 hours.

4 Sailing Instructions & Division Assignments

4.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/8285> paper copies will also be available at Fayerweather Yacht Club and Black Rock Yacht Clubs

4.2 The Division assignments are:

Division 1 – JAM - All single handed boats

Division 1 – JAM – All double handed boats

Division assignments may be altered at the discretion of the organizing authority.

5 Penalty System

Rule 44.2 is changed to require one full turn instead of two. 6.1 The Low-Point Scoring System in RRS Appendix A will apply, except that Rule A2 is changed to exclude the worst scores for each boat for all races in excess of 60% of the total number of races completed in the series. At least one race must be completed to constitute the Series.

6.2 YRA of LIS, PHRF “time on time” scoring procedure will be used. $TCF=650/(550+PHRF)$

6.3 For the purpose of calculating 60% of the total number of races sailed will be multiplied by .6 and rounded upward.

6.4 A boat serving as Race Committee will be scored as having competed in that race, and will be assigned a score equal to her average for **all** races sailed in the series. Rounded to the nearest, whole number (.5 to be rounded upward)

7 Trophies

7.1 The first, second, and third (if 5 or more boats qualify) place winners of the Series in each Division will be awarded “Black Rock Harbor Single/Double Series” trophies at the awards night held at Fayerweather Yacht Club on November 1, 2014. If a division does not have at least 3 qualifying boats, all divisions will be combined and trophies will only be awarded for overall winners.

7.1 To be eligible for trophies, a boat must submit a current PHRF certificate from YRA of LIS no later than July 3, 2014.

7.2 Black Rock Yacht Club may also award trophies for their member’s top finishing boats that participated in the Series. The trophies are awarded at an awards night held at Black Rock Yacht Club. Boats wishing to compete for these awards must indicate their intention on the Series entry form and will be marked “BRYC” on the scratch sheets to provide notice to other BRYC competitors. To be eligible, a boat must be at least co-owned by a Black Rock Yacht Club member. Black Rock Yacht Club may also award additional trophies at BRYC’s discretion.
