Lake Norman Yacht Club, 297 Yacht Rd. Mooresville, NC, 28117 invites you to the 2014 Independence Day Regatta. Sailboat racing, great company, LNYC slow cooked BBQ dinner, entertainment and, of course, great FIREWORKS. Come and join the fun. Camping at the club is available. No fires or pets allowed.

1.0 RULES: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in 2013 – 2016 The Racing Rules of Sailing.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY: The Regatta is open to boats of all classes including juniors, and centerboards. Classes are open to both US Sailing members and non-members. Boats shall be divided into classes as determined by the race committee, based upon registration. One Design Classes shall consist of not less than three like boats, except a multi-class handicap fleet that may be formed at the discretion of the regatta committee.

3.0 REGISTRATION: Competitors may register via [Regatta Network](#). Regatta Shirts must be ordered and paid for by **Friday, June 20th**. To avoid late fees, registrations must be received and **paid for** no later than **Friday, June 27**, 2014. Late registrations may also be made onsite Friday July 4th 1600-1800 and Saturday July 5 between 0800 and 1100 at the registration desk at the LNYC clubhouse, and will have late fees assessed. Meal orders should be included in pre-registration to ensure availability and to support our hard working cooks and servers with advanced planning.

3.1 REGISTRATION FEES:

- \$45 Regatta fee for A-T-B Centerboards plus late fee of \$15 after 6/27
- \$20 Regatta fee for Juniors plus late fee of \$15 after 6/27
- \$13.00 Adult Dinner (Sat) plus late fee of \$5 after 6/27
- \$10.00 Child Dinner (Sat) Under 10 years old plus late fee of \$5 after 6/27
- \$3.00 Tramp Dinner (Sat) *Mac n Cheese and baked beans* (Under 10) plus late fee of \$5 after 6/27

5.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Official Bulletin Board located at the Race Management Center. Copies will be available at registration.

6.0 COURSES: There will be two race areas: Around the Buoys course will be for one-design fleets and potentially a miscellaneous fleet. Junior course will include Optimis, Sunfish, Lasers and 420s sailing around a buoys course. Around-the-Buoys courses and Junior courses to be sailed include Windward-Leeward, Triangle and Olympic.

7.0 SCORING: Scoring will be Low Point Scoring System Appendix A except that all races shall be scored (changes appendix A2). A minimum of one race constitutes a Regatta.

8.0 AWARDS: Trophies will be given in each class according to the following fleet sizes:

3-5 boats = 2 trophies

6-9 boats = 3 trophies

10-13 boats = 5 trophies

14-18 boats = 6 trophies

19+ boats = 7 trophies
