# Notice of Race

## 71st Annual Lahaina to Honolulu Race

Monday, September 1, 2014

Organizing Authority: Hawaii Yacht Club (HYC)

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The race will be conducted according to *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016 (RRS)* with US Sailing Prescriptions, excluding the prescriptions to rules 60, 63.2, 63.4; and Hawaii Yacht Racing Association [HYRA] Prescriptions unless otherwise amended in the Notice of Race or these Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. RRS 52 is modified to allow the use of winches operated using stored power.

2. ADVERTISING shall comply with ISAF Regulation 20. Competitor advertising will not be restricted.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all yachts that meet requirements for ISAF Offshore Special Regulations Category 3 (no liferaft required) and are members of HYRA member clubs, and other yachts that may be invited by the organizing authority.
- 3.2. Eligible yachts may enter via the US Sailing RegattaNetwork website up to August 27, 1800 hrs. Entries will only be accepted using the RegattaNetwork website.

- 3.3. **No late entries will be accepted after August 27, 2014.**
- 3.4. All Yachts shall enter race according to HYRA Spring Meeting 2014 class breaks as follows:
  - 3.4.1 X Fleet will be 30 spm and below
  - 3.4.2 A Fleet will be 31-110 spm
  - 3.4.3 B Fleet will be 111 and above
  - 3.4.4 Aloha Fleet will be non-spinnaker
  - 3.4.5 M Multihull
- 3.5 Yachts may be denied entry by the organizing authority

### 4. MOORING

- 4.1. Mooring in Lahaina prior to the regatta is available on a first-come, first serve basis. The Lahaina Small Boat Harbor typically has moorings and a limited number of slips available. The Harbor Agents can be reached at 808-662-4060. Lahaina Yacht Club (LYC) has several moorings available for visiting yachts. The LYC office can be reached at 808-661-0191.

4.2. Mooring in Waikiki after the regatta is available on a first come first serve basis. Temporary moorings may be available at the Ala Wai Harbor or at the HYC Aloha Dock. ## 6. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

6.1. Entry into LYC is restricted to members of LYC and their guests. Reciprocity will be granted to members of other recognized yacht clubs upon presentation of the membership card. Temporary membership cards to LYC will be available for crew members of racing yachts at no charge.

7. **MEASUREMENTS & HANDICAPS** Each boat shall have a valid Performance Handicap Racing Fleet [PHRF] handicap certificate or be assigned a temporary handicap.

## 8. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing instructions will be available via Regatta Network, at the skippers' meeting, and posted at the Lahaina Yacht Club lower deck.

**9. VENUE/COURSE**

The course will be a race from Honolua Bay, Maui to Ala Wai Boat Harbor, Oahu.

**10. SCORING**

9.1. Corrected times will be calculated using the PHRF Time-on-Time scoring system, as adopted by HYRA.

9.2. The low point system of RRS Appendix A shall apply without modification.

**11. PRIZES**

For each class, first prize will be awarded if at least three boats enter, second prize will be awarded if at least five boats enter, and third prize will be awarded if at least seven boats enter.

**12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**13. INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000 per event or the equivalent.
