## NOTICE of RACE

### 2014 JET 14 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP and 2014 JET 14 WOMEN'S/JUNIOR NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

**ORGANIZING AUTHORITY:** The organizing authority is the Mayfield Yacht Club (MYC), Mayfield, NY and the Jet 14 Class Association.

#### 1. RULES:

- 1.1. The Regatta will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and *prescriptions of US Sailing*.
- 1.2. The Jet 14 Constitution and By-Laws, except where changed in the Sailing Instructions.

#### 2. ADVERTISING:

- 2.1. IASF Regulation 20 will apply.

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY:

- 3.1. The Regatta is open to boats of the Jet 14 Class that conform to the Class rules.
- 3.2. To skipper in either the Jet 14 Women's or Jet 14 Open Nationals, skipper must be either a 2014 Active member (boat owners and co-owners) or a 2014 Associate or Junior member (co-owners and non-owners) who is skippering a boat that is owned by a 2014 Active member, and registered with the Jet 14 Class.
- 3.3. For the Junior Nationals, the skipper must be a 2014 Junior member, and skipper and crew shall not reach their respective 20<sup>th</sup> birthday before January 1, 2015.
- 3.4. All Active, Associate and Junior members must be in good standing with the Jet 14 Class to qualify.
- 3.5. Co-helming is allowed, provided both skippers meet the above requirements.
- 3.6. All competitors under 18 shall have parental permission.

#### 4. REGISTRATION:

- 4.1. Registration may be made in person at MYC the week of the Regatta or by either electronic or US mail using the appropriate event forms, together with all fees and measurement documents, by the date specified below.
- 4.2. Registration forms will be mailed to paid Jet 14 Class members, posted on the Class website and attached herein for convenience.

#### 5. FEES

- 5.1. Women's & Junior National Championships
  - 5.1.1. There will be no entry fee for either.
  - 5.1.2. No Meals or Tee-shirts included with registration.
  - 5.1.3. Registration closes 10:00 am, Wednesday August 13, 2014.

## 5.2. National (Open) Championship

5.2.1. \$185.00 per boat.

5.2.1.1. Entry fee is waived for any first time participant of a Jet 14 Nationals as owner and/or skipper.

5.2.1.2. Includes, along with authorization to race, continental breakfast each morning, snacks and beverages after racing, Friday night Class Dinner and two Tee-shirts.

5.2.2. Entries postmarked after July 25, 2014 will not include Tee-shirts.

5.2.3. Registration closes at 6:00 pm, Wednesday August 13, 2014.

## 6. MEASUREMENTS

6.1. Measurement forms will be available on-site, on the Jet 14 website and attached herein.

6.2. All boats are required to display the current 2014 Class membership decal in location as prescribed.

6.3. Measurements will occur commencing Tuesday, August 12 from 12:00 noon – 7:30 pm and Wednesday, August 13 from 9:00 am – 5:00 pm (Juniors and Women's only until 10:45 am).

## 8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

8.1. Sailing Instructions (SI) shall be available at registration.

## 9. VENUE

9.1. Mayfield Yacht Club, Mayfield, NY and the waters of the Great Sacandaga Lake, including Mayfield Bay and the waters north of Beacon Island.

## 10. COURSES:

10.1. Course shall be Windward-Leeward, drop mark as per Sailing Instructions.

## 11. SCORING:

- 11.1. Low point scoring system of Appendix A of RRS will apply.
- 11.2. National Championship
  - 11.2.1. Up to 10 races are expected.
  - 11.2.2. Three (3) completed races are required to award a Championship.
  - 11.2.3. If six (6) or more races are completed, there shall be one (1) exclusion as per RRS.
- 11.3. Women's & Junior National Championships
  - 11.3.1. Up to five (5) races are expected.
  - 11.3.2. One (1) completed race shall constitute a series/championship.
  - 11.3.3. There shall be no exclusions.

**12. AWARDS:**

- 12.1. National Championship (trophies for skipper and crew)
  - 12.1.1. Chevron Fleet 1-10<sup>th</sup> Place
  - 12.1.2. President's Fleet 1-5<sup>th</sup> Place
  - 12.1.3. Class Perpetual Awards
- 12.2. Women's National Championship (trophies for skipper and crew)
  - 12.2.1. 1-3<sup>rd</sup> Place
- 12.3. Junior National Championship (trophies for skipper and crew)
  - 12.3.1. 1-3<sup>rd</sup> Place

**13. STORAGE & LAUNCHING:**

- 13.1. Boats may be stored and launched from designated areas beginning Tuesday, August 12<sup>th</sup>. See NOR Appendix A for further information.

**14. RADIO COMMUNICATION:**

- 14.1. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephone devices.
- 14.2. The Race Committee may make race announcements on VHF radio on a predetermined channel.

**15. SUPPORT BOATS:**

- 15.1. As applicable, detailed instruction regarding Support Boats shall be in the Sailing Instructions.

**16. INSURANCE:**

- 16.1. All participating boats shall be insured with a third-party insurance sufficient to cover liability for loss, damage, or personal injury or death.

**17. WAIVER OF LIABILITY:**

- 17.1. All competitors shall sign a waiver of liability at time of registration for loss, damage or injury to persons or property incurring in connection with this event or on the property of MYC and to release MYC, the Jet 14 Class Association, any sponsors of the event and their members, officers, governors, employees, agents and sponsors from any liability for such loss, damage, or injury. All competitors under the age of 18 years shall have parental permission..

## LODGING INFORMATION:

- 1) Tenting is allowed on the grounds and there are individual stall shower facilities in the clubhouse. 1a) If needed, there is one large (sleeps four-five easily) tent available, first request gets it.
- 2) Sleeping is also available in the “loft” room within the clubhouse (carpeted, but not private, though there are private changing rooms on same floor);
- 3) Some club members in the past have offered rooms at either their camps (cottages) or use of their boats. We will take names and find housing on a first-come-first serve basis. This will be coordinated well before August so if out of berths, you can still make other arrangements.
- 4) There is a state campground 20 minutes north in Northhampton Beach and
- 5) A couple of national chain hotels are south in the Johnston/Gloversville area (approximately 15 minutes south on Route 30). Please Note: Room blocks have NOT been reserved.

## Directions to Mayfield Yacht Club/The Great Sacandaga Lake



### **From East on Route 90 (NY Thruway):**

Take Exit 27 north through Amsterdam on Route 30.

Continue on 30 in Vails Mills/Broadalbin past the Fulton County Welcome Center at Route 29.

Shortly after the 29/30 intersection, make a left turn at light to continue on Route 30 at the flashing light.

Approximately 2 miles later, turn right onto School Street in Mayfield (Shortly past the Fuel-n-Food Sunoco station on left, which has great subs if you need to stop on the way or pack a lunch.)

Cross over bridge/dam and at top of hill

Turn right onto Lakeside Drive. The Mayfield Yacht Club is on the right (at red barn).

**From West on Route 90 (NY Thruway):**

Take Exit 28 North to Route 30A.

Follow 30A through Fonda, Johnstown, and Gloversville.

Shortly after entering Mayfield, though still on Route 30, turn right on Main Street (At Stewarts) and Left onto Lakeside Drive.

The Mayfield Yacht Club is on the right (at red barn).

**STORAGE/LAUNCHING OF BOATS:**

An area for staging/rigging/storage of Jets (dollies or rigged on trailer) is at end of the MYC drive by the water. The weigh frame will also be located in this area and will remain in-place until at least late afternoon Sat. Aug. 16th.

**Please Note:** All “road” trailers not used for launching during the course of the regatta must be stored behind the barn for the duration of the regatta (this applies only for those boats on dollies or left in water).

After launching each day, trailer or dolly shall be stored in the designated Jet storage area during racing (i.e. can’t leave at ramp, but doesn’t have to go behind barn).

Launching is from the gravel ramp adjacent to this area. Please note that the end of this ramp may be muddy by mid-August, but usually can still be negotiated by either a hand-dolly or a car pulling a trailer (there will also be a four-wheel drive with a 1 7/8” ball available if necessary).

If desired, the option to leave a boat in the water for the duration is possible on the junior dock just adjacent to the launch ramp (first-come-first-serve basis). This area is protected from prevailing winds and has good vinyl edging. It is also available for rigging of dry-sailed boats each day (as space is available).
