ENTRIES: The Harvest Moon Regatta is open to yachtsmen. Races will be scheduled for Thistle, Highlander, Lightning, Flying Scot, Laser, Sunfish and Cruising Class boats. The Cruising Class will be sailed in three divisions: Racer-Cruiser I (for example; S2-7.9, J-22/24,), Cruiser II (yachts 25 ft & over, jib and main only), Cruiser III (yachts under 25 ft, jib and main only). Sunfish Class is restricted to Junior Sailors, age 18 and under.

This year, Atwood Yacht Club is honored to host the 2015 Flying Scot Sailing Association Ohio District Championship in conjunction with the Harvest Moon Regatta. The FSSA Ohio District Championship is open to skippers who are members of the Flying Scot Sailing Association with primary residence in, or belonging to a Fleet within the FSSA Ohio District.

Registration may be made electronically or by paper form: entries may be made by visiting www.atwoodyc.com and clicking on the link titled Harvest Moon Regatta. The website has a link to the online entry form on www.regattanetwork.com/event/8993.

REGISTRATION FEE: After filling out the registration form, either online or paper, you may pay via credit card on the registration website or mail a check made payable to Atwood Yacht Club to: AYC Harvest Moon Regatta, Atwood Yacht Club, PO Box 55, Dellroy, Ohio 44620.

Cruising Classes and One Designs paid before September 1, 2015: \$75.00

Cruising Classes and One Designs paid after August 31, 2015: \$95.00

Junior Sunfish Class: \$20.00

Cruising and one design fee includes racing awards and social events connected with the Regatta for skipper and up to three crew. Crew mementos will be provided up to a maximum of four per yacht.

SAFETY: Boats must comply with all safety requirements prescribed by the State of Ohio.

BERTHING & LAUNCHING: Assistance will be available for launching all yachts. Ample trailer space is available. A hoist is available for launching One Design Yachts.

TROPHIES: Award flags will be given for the first three places in each class or division. Trophies will be given to first through third place junior sunfish sailors.

FOOD SERVICE: A Saturday and Sunday breakfast buffet is included in the Registration Fee, along with a sack lunch snack on Saturday. Lunch and dinner may also be purchased at the clubhouse.

POOL: The AYC heated pool will be open with a pool lifeguard from 1100 until 1900 hours.

PETS: Pets are NOT permitted on AYC grounds.

LOCATION: The Atwood Yacht Club is located on Lodge Road (Route 542) three miles west of Dellroy, Ohio. From Route 212, turn Northeast onto Route 542. The Club is on the left after you pass Atwood Lake Resort. Google maps link: <http://goo.gl/v5KO4q>

LODGING: Limited camping space is available on the club lawn in front of the parking lot and West of the Pool-house and Racing Shanty. Restrooms and shower facilities are available.
