YACHT CLUB TEAM CHALLENGE

The Association of Santa Monica Bay Yacht Clubs invites all yacht clubs to enter a team(s) to compete for the ASMBYC Yacht Club Challenge Trophy. There is no entry fee for this Challenge.

The ASMBYC Yacht Club Challenge Trophy will be presented to the yacht club whose 3-boat team has the lowest combined score, counting each boat's final class standing as one score, during the 2009 ASMBYC Champion of Champions Regatta.

CHALLENGE FORMAT:

- Each yacht club may enter up to three (3) individual teams. Each team entered is a separate entity. No single boat may be entered on more than one (1) team. No two (2) boats on any team may be competing in the same one-design or PHRF class. PHRF class splits will be posted by 1200 hours on Friday, September 19, 2014.
- Each yacht club competing for the ASMBYC Yacht Club Challenge Trophy must declare their 3-boat team(s) no later than 1000 hours on September 26, 2009. Late entries will be accepted only with the prior approval of the regatta chairman. Boat substitutions may not be made after the entry deadline.
- The skipper of each boat on a team must be a member in good standing of the yacht club he/she is representing.
- The yacht club with the lowest cumulative combined score of its three-boat team, counting each boat's final class standing as one score, shall be the winner of the ASMBYC Yacht Club Challenge Trophy, which shall remain on display at the winning yacht club until the 2010 event. In case of a tie on points, the winner shall be the yacht club team with the most number of firsts in the final class standings, then seconds, then thirds, etc. If this fails to break the tie, the trophy will be awarded to the team who has the lowest combined scores in the final race.
