- 5. Classes are expected to be Spinnaker, Non-Spinnakerm multihull and cruising. Each class can be further divided into divisions based on rating ranges and number of entries.
- 6. The scoring will be PHRF time on time.
- 7. The courses will be around buoys and government marks, including windward, leeward or reaching marks.
- 8. Scoring will be changed to include Appendix T change T1
- 9. The regatta schedule will be:
 - a. Skippers meeting at 9:00 Saturday, September 13, 2014
 - b. First signal will be at 10:55 on September 13, 2014
 - c. Social directly after racing at BSC on Saturday
 - d. Awards will be at the post race social

- 11. Race entry will be \$30.
