NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the Prescriptions of US Sailing, the ISSA Procedural Rules, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions. In the event of a conflict the Sailing Instructions shall take precedence

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. Competing schools must be members of ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules.
- 2.2. Team must be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school.
- 2.3. For more detailed eligibility rules view the Nor Cal Notice of Series.

3. ENTRY & COMMUNICATIONS

- 3.1. Teams must register online and pay all applicable fees at the regatta website prior to 1700 Wednesday October 1, 2014.
- 3.2. Registration, liability forms and entry lists will be available online at <u>http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/9128</u>
- 3.3. Each team shall consist of at least two sailors, one skipper and one crew. A school may enter multiple teams. Registration will be closed once 60 boats have registered.

4. ENTRY FEE

- 4.1. The entry fee is \$20 per sailor. This includes breakfast, racing, a on the water snack, trophy snack and awards. A full lunch will not be provided.
- 4.2. The entry fee shall be submitted prior to 1700 Wednesday October 1, 2014 via the event website.

5. BOATS

5.1. Each team must provide their own class legal CFJ, with sails and all rigging. Boats will not be rotated.

6. SCHEDULE

Saturday October 4, 2014

- 0830-0930 Launch boats at public boat ramp
- 0930-1015 Registration/Check In & Breakfast
- 1015 Competitors Meeting
- 1100 First Start
- 1600 No Start After
- 1700 Awards and snacks at SYC
- 6.1. Changes to the schedule will be posted on the official notice board located in the club main dinning room.

7. RIGGING AND LAUNCHING

7.1. Clubs that can arrange for their boats to come by water are strongly encouraged to do so. Coach Boats and sailboats can be tied up at the main dock or on a mooring ball and then shuttled to dock by coach boat.

- 7.2. Teams coming with trailers and coach boat trailers must launch at the Sausalito Public Launch Ramp next to 1200 Bridgeway, Sausalito. Please keep in mind that this is a public launch ramp.
- 7.3. Trailer storage will be available in a lot adjacent to SYC. Dollies must be stored on trailers after boats are launched. Trailers cannot be stored in the club's parking lot.
- 7.4. A MAP OF LAUNCHING AND TRAILER STORAGE LOCATION WILL BE INCLUDED IN THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

8.1. Sailing Instructions will be available by September 29, 2014.

9. RACING AREA

9.1. The racing area will be either in Richardson Bay or Hurricane Gulch areas.

10. COACHING

Coaching on the water is permitted between races from a coach boat. After the warning signal coaching is not permitted until the boat has finished the race and cleared the finish area. Coach boats shall stay at least 100 feet away from all boats while racing.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

All competitors must sign a release waiver in order to participate at the regatta. Waivers will be available online and at Check In. Waivers must be signed by a parent or legal guardian.

12. **DECISIONS OF THE JURY** will be final in accordance with RRS Rule 70.5.

13. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded to teams placing 1st, 2nd, and 3rd, in Gold and Silver Fleets.
