NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority is South Beach Yacht Club

1. Rules

- This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- b. RRS 40 is deleted and replaced with "All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices at all times while racing except for short periods of time to adjust or change clothing. Wet suits are not considered personal flotation devices". No Y flag shall be displayed.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- a. The regatta is open to all boats that have a 2014 and/or 2015 Northern California PHRF certificate.
- b. Any boat without a certificate will be assigned a PHRF rating at the sole and un-appealable discretion of the Race Committee.
- c. No changes will be made to PHRF after the start of the series.
- d. Eligible boats must enter and pay on-line at www.regattanetwork.com/event. Only on-line entries and payments will be accepted. Deadline to register for the series without a late fee is November 12, 2014, 23:59.
- e. Changes to Divisions will not be made after November 13th.
- f. One design fleets will be made at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

3. Fees

- a. Series: Entry fee = \$50. Entries received after November 12th = \$55.
- b. Single Race = \$15
 - i. Single race entries must be received no later than 1800 the day before the race.
 - ii. Single race entries will not be eligible for series and will be deleted from the results approximately 48 hours after the race.

4. Schedule of Races

- a. Dates of Racing: Series consists of 5 races
 - i. 2014: 11/15, 12/20
 - ii. 2015: 1/17, 2/21, 3/21
- b. The scheduled time for the first Warning Signal is 1230 hours.

5. Sailing Instructions

- a. The sailing instructions will be available after Thursday, November 13th at 1700 hours on the club website at www.southbeachyachtclub.org or www.regattanetwork.com/event/9212.
- 6. Courses and Racing Area
 - a. The races will be held in the South and Central waters of the San Francisco Bay.
 - b. Courses will use a combination of fixed/temporary marks or landmarks such as islands.

7. Scoring

- a. Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- b. When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- c. When four to five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- d. Time on distance correction will be used; corrected times will be calculated to the nearest second.

8. Prizes

- a. Prizes will be given after each race to the first place winner in each division.
- b. Prizes for first, second and third places for each division will be awarded at the end of the Series at a club-hosted reception.

9. Disclaimer of Liability

a. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
