Handicap Rating (PHRF)

If your head sail will always be 110% or less for all races in the Spring series you may add 9 points to your base PHRF.

If you are not using a spinnaker in any race during the Spring series you may add 15 points to your base PHRF.

Assignment to Division

- One-Design divisions will be allowed upon request by fleets with at least five (5) boats, provided enough entries are received.
- Final division assignments will be made on the first day of the series.
