

RULES: This race will be governed by the Racing Rules of sailing.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Del Rey Yacht Club members, spouses, family and friends, with keel boats and a VHF radio. **All skippers and helms-persons must be members of DRYC.**

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing Instructions will be available at the club and will be posted on the <u>www.dryc.org</u> website on Thursday, November 20 at 0900.

CLASSES: Classes will be established at the skippers meeting for PHRF, Novice and Cruising Class racers. Inclusion in the Novice, Cruising Class will be at the discretion of the Race Committee. Novice and Cruising class boats that have trophied may be moved into the PHRF division. Boats that have won trophies in PHRF events or One Design are not eligible to participate in Cruising class.

SCHEDULE: The order and time of starts will be explained at the skippers meeting. The first warning will be at 1155 hrs.

COURSE: There will be one race. The Start line will be in the vicinity of "S" Mark and the Finish line will be in the vicinity of the DRYC main channel dock. The course will be Random Leg. No Spinnakers may be carried inside the detached breakwater. All boats not finishing by 1630 will be scored DNF.

MANDATORY SKIPPERS MEETING: Sunday, November 23 at 0930. Any race announcements, class splits of PHRF Fleet will be announced at the skippers meeting & posted on the racing board.

ENTRIES: There is <u>NO</u> Entry Fee. Race info is at <u>www.dryc.org</u>. On line entry is at <u>http://www.regattanetwork.com/html/calendar.html</u> until 1800 hours Saturday, November 22. Paper entry forms (available at the Race Bulletin Board) must be mailed, faxed or brought to DRYC no later than 1800 hours on Saturday, November 22.

Novice - Cruiser handicap forms (available at the Race Bulletin Board or may be available to print out at dryc.org) must be mailed, faxed or brought to DRYC no later than 1800 on Saturday, November 22. Novice – Cruisers not meeting the 1800 deadline on Saturday, November 22, will race with their PHRF So Cal rating with no adjustments. No exceptions.

HANDICAP & RATINGS: The DRYC Cruising Handicaps (PHRF area B RLC adjusted) will be used for the Cruising Fleet for this race. Cruisers without handicaps will be assigned one by the Race Chair. PHRF area B RLC Ratings will be used for PHRF Classes.
