Sail Numbers: All competitors must sail boat with same sail number throughout series. Sail number must

accompany registration. Competitor is responsible for verifying sail number at check in for each

race. Sail numbers not in registration data base will not be scored.

Wet Suits or dry suits mandatory for competitors 17 years and younger on Southampton Course only.

Classes: Classes with 5 or more boats registered prior to 3:00 pm on Saturday, December 6, 2014 will be

sailed and scored as One Design. All other boats will be sailed as Open Class. Classes with 3 or 4 boats registered prior to 3pm on Saturday, December 6 2014 will sail in their respective Open Class, but will be scored separately. Two or more classes may be started together at the discretion of

the race committee.

Handicaps: Southampton Open Class boats will be scored using the TOT (time on time) scoring system and

the Portsmouth Yardstick number listed by US Sailing in the "Table of North American Portsmouth
