**1. Organizing Authority**

The organizing authority is the Sarasota Sailing Squadron

**2. Rules**

This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and applicable One Design Class Rules.

**3. Eligibility**

The regatta is open to all one design classes with five or more entries. Expected classes include Flying Scot, S2 7.9, E Scows, MC Scows, Albacore, Daysailer, VX One, Vipers and Windmill.

**4. Registration & Fees**

- 4.1. 3-day racing:\$95,per boat; includes 2 Friday dinners, 2 Saturday dinners and 1 t-shirt.
- 4.2. 2-day racing:\$75,per boat;includes 2 Saturday dinners and 1 t-shirt.
- 4.3. \$25 Late Fee for paid registrations received after midnight March 3rd, 2015.
- 4.4. Extra dinner tickets Friday \$15, Saturday \$18; Extra T-Shirts \$15 will be available online and onsite during registration.

**Sunday, March 22nd, 2015**

- 1000 Warning Signal first race of the day.  
1330 No new races to start after this time.

Award presentation ASAP after racing.

**6. Sailing Instructions**

Sailing Instructions and Courses will be available at Registration.

**7. Race Area**

Racing will be in Sarasota Bay.

**8. Scoring**

- 8.1. **One race will constitute a regatta.**
- 8.2. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes RRS A2.

**9. Prizes**

Awards will be given out according to the number of registrants in each class.

**10. Disclaimer of Liability**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**11. Parking**

Parking is available for trailers and cars outside the main entrance. Vehicles parked blocking SSS members' boats will be towed.

**12. Accommodations**
