# 2014 Cal 20 Pig Out Summer Series

### Every Other Tuesday through the Summer:

## June 9<sup>th</sup> / June 23<sup>th</sup> / July 7<sup>th</sup> / July 21<sup>st</sup> / August 4<sup>th</sup> / August 18<sup>th</sup> / September 1<sup>st</sup>

### 1. **RULES:**

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US SAILING, pertinent Class/Fleet Rules, the Waikiki Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to Cal 20s with skippers who are members of HYRA member clubs.
- 2.2. Yachts will be scored in a class if there are 3 or more entries
- 2.3. Eligible boats may enter by registering on Regatta Network by **July 7<sup>th</sup>**: <u>http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/9660</u>
- 2.4. WYC Charter Cal 20 can be reserved on a first come first serve basis via the Google Doc Spreadsheet for each individual race day.
- 2.5. Skippers will rotate boats. A skipper chartering a WYC boat may not use the same boat twice. RC may change boat assignments to correct complications.
- 3. FEES: There is a \$20 entry fee. Standard Tuesday night charter fees apply

#### 4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. Boats may register prior to the skippers meeting via Regatta Network before July 7th
- **4.2.** Skippers' Meeting: June 9<sup>th</sup> at 1700.
- 4.3. First Warning: 1800 on each race day
- 4.4. Number of Races: There will be three races each day. Twenty-one races for the series.
- 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skippers Meeting on June 9<sup>th</sup> and at the Cal 20 board
- 6. VENUE: The Course Area will off the south shore of Oahu
- 7. COURCES: Courses will be displayed by the Race Committee at or prior to the warning of the race as described in the Sailing Instructions
- 8. SCORING: The scoring systems is as follows:
  - 8.1. The Low Point Scoring System will be used
  - **8.2.** 12 races are required to be complete to constitute a series
  - 8.3. When 18 races are completed, a boat series score shall exclude 6 worst scores
  - **8.4.** Skippers not present for a race will be scored Did Not Compete for the days race results (# of entrants plus 1)
- 9. PRIZES: Prizes will be presented at the awards ceremony on August 19th. The WYC One-Design Cup Perpetual will be award to the overall winner of the series
