The Organizing Authority (OA) is South Coast Corinthian Yacht Club.

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 This series will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 One design classes will be subject to the rules of their respective class.
- 1.3 Certain rules may be changed, and these changes will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

2. ADVERTISING

2.1 Advertising shall be in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20. Competitors may be required to display graphics on the side of their hulls; these graphics will be supplied by the OA.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The event is open to one-design dinghies.
- 3.2 Classes have been established for Lido 14 and Coronado 15. Other dinghy classes wishing enter the event must contact the Series Chairman in advance.
- 3.3 Membership in the one design class association is required.
- 3.4 US Sailing Membership is encouraged.
- 3.5 To be eligible to compete in any race of the series, competitors must complete and sign an SCCYC Entry Form and submit an entry fee prior to 1700 hours on the evening in which they first compete. Competitors under eighteen years of age must have their entry form signed by a parent or guardian.

4. FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee for each evening is \$10 for members of US SAILING with proof of membership (\$12 for non- members).
- 4.2 The series entry fee is \$55 for single-handed classes and \$75 for double-handed classes. Members of U.S. Sailing receive a \$10 discount on the entry fee.
- 4.3 For competitors under 18 years of age, the series entry fee is \$30 for single-handed classes and \$45 for double-handed classes.

5. SCHEDULE

5.1 The Starting Signal will be at 1800 hours for the first race each evening, with five (5) races scheduled. The Race Committee, at its discretion, may run fewer races.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 The Sailing Instructions and Sunstroke Series Course Chart will be available at SCCYC beginning Thursday, May 7, and may be posted at www.sccyc.org prior.

7. VENUE

The race area will be in the main channel, inside of the Marina del Rey breakwater, just west of the UCLA sailing center

8. COURSES

Courses will be primarily windward / leeward selected from the 2015 Sunstroke Series Course Chart.

9. SCORING

Each night of the series will be scored using the Low Point System. A boat's series score will be determined using the Low Point System using the results of each week as a single score, with three throw-outs. See the SIs for details.

10. MEDIA RIGHTS

By participating in this regatta, a competitor (or parent/guardian if under age 18) grants to the OA and its sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photographs, motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the period of the competition without compensation.

11. PRIZES

Prizes for each evening will be awarded at SCCYC, as soon as possible after racing. Trophies for the series will be awarded on Thurs, Aug. 27th.
