

Notice of Race
J22 Spring Regatta
March 28 & 29, 2015
LCYC & J22 Fleet 17

LCYC J22 Fleet 17 invites you to attend the J22 Spring Regatta to be held March 28 & 29, 2015 at Lake Canyon Yacht Club. This is a five race Regatta with the option for a sixth race.

1. Rules

1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and the international J22 Class Association Rules (IJ22CA). The sailing instructions will be distributed at registration.

1.2 RRS Rule 87 will be changed as follows: The sailing instructions may change a class rule.

1.3 RRS Appendix A2 will be changed to read as follows: each competitor's series scores shall be the total of their race scores, there will be no throw outs. A race is completed if scored; see rule 90.3(a). The competitor with the lowest series score wins and others will be ranked accordingly.

1.4 Class rules 2.8 (eligibility), 2.9 (measurement certificate) and 8.9 (weight limit) of the IJ22CA Class Rules will not apply for eligibility to participate in this event.

2 Advertising

This Regatta is classified as a Category C event per ISAF Regulation 20 as modified by the International J22 Class Association (IJ22CA) Class Rule 2.9.8(a).

3 Eligibility

J22 Class Yachts in compliance with IJ22CA Rules will be scored. Boats without a valid measurement certificate or do not meet the class crew weight may participate, be scored and receive appropriate trophies. US Sailing & J22 class membership is strongly encouraged, but not required.

4 Entry and Fees

4.1 The entry fee is \$55.00 (early registration) through March 27, 2015 11:59 pm. Late registration \$65.00 March 28 12:00 am until 09:30 am. Late registration will close March 28, 2015 at 09:30 am. Register online at www.lcyc.net.

4.2 Entry fees will include lunch and dinner on Saturday, breakfast and lunch on Sunday.

5 Schedules

5.3 Days of Racing	Saturday March 28	11:30 am. First Signal, up to 4 races to follow.
	Sunday March 29	10:00 am. First signal No warning signal after 1:00pm.

6 Measurement

It is expected that all yachts meet IJ22CA Class Rules. A measurement certificate is not required to enter/participate.

7 Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be distributed at registration

8 Venue

The course will be sailed on Canyon Lake.

9 Courses

Racing will take place on Windward/Leeward courses or variations thereof. Offset weather marks and leeward gates maybe used.

10 Scoring

Five races are scheduled with the option of a 6th race. One race completed constitutes a Regatta. No races will be discarded, this changes Appendix A2.

11 Radio Communications

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

12 Trophies

Trophies will be awarded for the top 4 finishers.

13 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, of after the Regatta.
