1. Organizing Authorities

The organizing authority is the Sarasota Sailing Squadron

2. Rules

This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the West Florida PHRF Class Rules. This is a category 5 event per WFPHRF class rules for the race in the Bay. Random Leg Rating will apply.

3. Eligibility

The regatta is open to all WFPHRF boats, Multihulls and Portsmouth boats. PHRF Fleets include: Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker, Racer Cruiser, Cruiser, Pocket Cruiser & Multihull. Portsmouth fleets include any boats with a Portsmouth rating and any fleets with 3 or more boats will be also scored separately and together.

4. Registration & Fees

- **4.1** Registration is \$40 per boat. All registrations received from April 20th to April 25th will be charged a \$25 late fee. Registration fee includes 1 dinner ticket, 1 t-shirt, and complimentary refreshments.
- **4.2** Online Registration is available at regattanetwork.com. Extra dinner tickets and t-shirts are also available through the online registration.

5. Ratings and Class Rules

Boats sailing in the PHRF fleets must have a valid WFPHRF certificate and have a copy of the certificate available. Rating certificates are available online at westfloridaphrf.org. All boats must carry applicable U.S. Coast Guard required equipment. In the event that there are insufficient entries for a Pocket Cruiser they will race in Cruiser Class. Three boats or more will constitute a Class.
