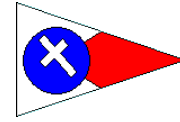

NOTICE OF RACE

2015 SPRING SCORE / DOUBLE HANDED SERIES

April 26, May 24 and June 28 of 2015

1 Rules

- 1.1 The series will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Rule 40 will be changed to require competitors to wear a personal flotation device while racing.
- 1.3 Rules 41 and 62.1(a) will be modified to allow the Race Committee at their discretion to hail boats at the start who are On Course Side (OCS) via Channel 68 and this will not be considered outside assistance.
- 1.4 Rule 41 will be changed to replace the Two-Turn penalty with a One-Turn Penalty
- 1.5 Rule 55 will be changed in the sailing instructions by adding the following sentence to the rule: 'However, discarding biodegradable sail stops when setting a sail will not be considered a breach of rule 55.'

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 This series is open to any boat holding a valid 2015 Monterey Bay PHRF certificate.
- 2.2 There will be a Double Handed division, and the following PHRF divisions: A fleet (86 or less), B Fleet (greater than 86), Jib & Main (181 or less) and Jib & Main (greater than 181). Double Handed division shall have exactly two persons on board. PHRF divisions shall have a minimum of two persons on board.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/10032> or from the event information link found at <http://scyc.org/racing> . Only on-line entries will be accepted.

3 Fees

- 3.1 The regular entry fee is \$90 and is applicable if entry is completed by 2000 hours on Saturday, April 25, 2015.
- 3.2 A late entry fee of \$110.00 is applied to all entries received after 2000 hours on Saturday, April 25, 2015.
- 3.3 Registration closes at 1100 hours on Sunday, June 28, 2015.
- 3.4 All entry fees are nonrefundable.

4 Schedules

- 4.1 A competitors' meeting is scheduled for 1030 hours on Sunday, April 26, 2015 at the SCYC clubhouse.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1225 hours each race day.
- 4.3 Six races are scheduled for the series. There will be two races each day. Three (3) races will constitute a series.
- 4.5 There will be an awards ceremony at the SCYC clubhouse for daily prizes each race day immediately after racing, and a final awards ceremony at the SCYC clubhouse following racing on June 28st.

5 Sailing Instructions

- 5.1 The sailing instructions will be available at the competitors' meeting and online. Courses will be distributed with the sailing instructions.

6 Venues

- 6.1 Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys or fixed buoys in the area bounded by Moss Landing to the southeast, Davenport to the northwest and extending up to five miles off shore.

7 Scoring

- 7.1 When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes rule A2.

8 Prizes

- 8.1 Prizes will be given at the discretion of the organizing authority. Boats entered in divisions with three (3) or more entries in the series are eligible for the Champion of Champions Regatta.
