These classes will feature on the water sailing training at the Lake Lanier Sailing Club designed to help you develop sailing skills. There are 3 choices of classes to fit anyone's needs. These are open class to the Atlanta sailing community to foster growth and education in our sport, LLSC membership is not required. All classes will be taught in the Flying Scot sailboat - which is a 19' cruiser/racer sailboat that offers variety of options to learn to sail or for the more avid one design racer. ## <u>Class #1 – Adult Sailing 101</u>

Want to start your path to sailing as a sport, need a refresher course or just want to refresh your basic skills – this is the class for you. Taught by Level I certified US Sailing coaches, this class will offer you the basic skills to get off the dock, sailing safely and confidently in a variety of conditions, while returning to the dock safely. Each class is designed to be 3 hours long with 2+ hours on the water and~ 45 minutes of rigging, chalk talk and de-rigging.
