1. Organizing Authority The organizing authority is the Flying Dutchman Class of NA

2. Venue

2.1 The regatta venue is Coronado Yacht Club, California

2.2 The racing area will be San Diego's South Bay

3. Rules

The event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (except as changed by this notice of race or the sailing instructions), the prescriptions of US SAILING, the rules of the International Flying Dutchman Class, this notice of race, and the sailing instructions.

4. Eligibility

The regatta is restricted to Flying Dutchman class boats. Both crew members must be current members of the IFDCAUS.

5. Registration

5.1 Competitors are urged to register online in advance with the Regatta Network portal via the Coronado Yacht Club (CYC) website. This can be found under the "racing" tab. Alternatively you can post in the completed entry form below, accompanied with a check.

5.2 Registration will be on Thursday, April 16 at Coronado Yacht Club from 1600 hrs to 1800 hrs. Registration will also be at CYC Friday, April 17 from 0800 to 0900 hrs.

5.3 Completed entry forms, and fees must be received no later than 0900 hrs Friday 4/17

6. Entry Fee

6.1 Entry fee includes three days of racing.

6.2 Entry fee will be \$150 Checks should be made out to CYC.

The proposed courses will be either, triangle WLW or WLW. Number of windward legs will be shown on the RC Signal boat. Course legs will be as close to 1.25 miles as possible in the confines of South Bay. Final course details will be decided by CYC and be posted in the Sailing Instructions.

9. Sailing Instructions Sailing instructions will be available at registration.
