

#### NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

- **1.1** The regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)* and the USODA conditions.
- **1.2** All competitors are required to wear a life jacket or other adequate personal floatation device while racing. RRS 40 is changed as follows: The "Y" flag will not be displayed.

### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

**2.1** All Optimist fleets are invited to participate.

Eligible boats shall enter by completing the online entry form at <u>www.stfyc.com</u> and submitting the attached waiver to the StFYCRace Office (email to <u>racing@stfyc.com</u> or hand deliver).

#### 3 FEES

Entry fee for the regatta is \$120 **if received on or before June 17, 2015**. A \$20 late fee will be assessed for entries received June 18, 2015 or later. Entry fee includes continental breakfast, lunch, and snacks on each day of racing.

# 5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

# 6 RACING AREA

The intended race areas will either be the waters between Fort Mason and the San Francisco Marina or on the City Front directly north of the St. Francis clubhouse.

### 7 SCORING

- 7.1 One race shall constitute a series. As many races as possible will be attempted.
- **7.2** The Opti Heavy Weather Regatta will be scored as a three-day series (June 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>, & 21<sup>st</sup>). If fewer than five races are completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores. If five or more races are completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes RRS A2.

Competitors shall participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (see Rule 4, DECISION TO RACE). The organizing authority does not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

### **BERTHING, HAUL OUT & TRAILER STORAGE**
