

2015 LIYC MIDSUMMER REGATTA Lido Isle Yacht Club NOTICE OF RACE Saturday & Sunday, July 25-26, 2015 AMENDED 7/21/15



### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and by the INSA class rules. Any changes will be addressed in the Competitors Meeting and/or the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 USCG approved PFD's shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This modifies RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to Sabot C3-A, Lasers, CFJs, Teras, Fevas, and any other class with 4 or more boats.
- Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form and paying the entry fee at <u>www.liyc.net</u> by
   5:00pm Friday, July 24, 2015. All entries received after 5:00pm, Friday, July 24 will be subject to a \$10
   late fee. Day of registration, in person, will be accepted. All entry fees are non-refundable.

#### 3. ENTRY FEE

\$20 Sabots, Lasers & Teras
\$25 CFJs & Fevas
(\$10 Late fee for all day of entries, online registration closes 5:00pm 07/24/2015)

#### 4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

4.1 <u>Mandatory Check –In:</u> All competitors must check in prior to his/her fleet Competitor's meeting.

#### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at check-in on Saturday morning.

#### 6. VENUE AND COURSES

- 6.1 Boat launching: Coach Boats may be launched at Genoa East (please contact Sailing Director for more information).
- 6.2 Racing will take place in the Lido Channel or in the Harbor east of LIYC Dock. Street parking is available; please do not park in front of garages or in red zones.

6.3 Courses may be windward-leeward or any variation of a triangular or other course. Course diagrams will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

### 7. FORMAT & SCORING

- 7.1 The regatta format will be determined at the close of registration. It will be based on the number of entries in each fleet and the forecasted weather conditions. It is the intent of the Race Committee to sail fleets that exceed 36 entries in flights.
- 7.2 Two (2) races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 7.3 When five (5) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

# 8. TROPHIES

8.1 Trophies will be awarded as soon as possible after racing. Trophies for the Sabot C2 and C3 sailors will be awarded separate from the Teras, Fevas, Sabot C1, B, A, Lasers and CFJs due to split race times.

# 9. DISCLAIMER

9.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage or injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
