The Regatta will be governed by the 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing. All boats shall comply with N.C. Wildlife Commission and U.S. Coast Guard safety regulations.

Expected One-Design classes (SJ21, Sunfish, FJs, Tanzers, 420s, Ensigns, etc.) will race near in Northwest Creek and possibly nearby in the Neuse River, weather permitting. Multiple races are planned.

The Edward Teach Youth Sailing Association (ETYSA) will display a new International Topper Dinghy which they are raffling off to help benefit youth sailing. Tickets are \$5 apiece or 3 for \$10 and are available online (see www.etysa.org/topper-raffle) or they will be gladly sold at the social. The funds raised will help the ETYSA purchase equipment, train instructors, and provide scholarships opportunities for those in need! <u>Classes.</u> A minimum of two boats will constitute a class. There may be classes for spinnaker and non-spinnaker. Each fleet may be broken into multiple classes depending on the number of entries, at the discretion of the Principal Race Officer.

Scoring. Cinco de Mayo Regatta – One-design racing scoring
