

NOTICE OF RACE

2015 MOORE 24 PACIFIC COAST CHAMPIONSHIP

MAY 16-17, 2015

1 Rule

- 1.1 The series will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Rule 40 will be changed to require competitors to wear a personal flotation device while racing.
- 1.3 The sailing instructions will alter RRS rule 44.1 replacing a two-turns penalty with a one-turn penalty.
- 1.4 Changes to the rules will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Boats of the Moore 24 class are eligible to participate in this regatta.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at https://www.regattanetwork.com/clubmgmt/applet_registration_form.php?regatta_id=10343 or at scyc.org. Only on-line entries will be accepted.

3 Fees

- 3.1 The regular entry fee is \$125.00 and is applicable if entry is completed by 2000 hour on Wednesday, May 13, 2015.
- 3.2 The entry fee of \$150.00 is applied to all entries received after 2000 hours on Wednesday, May 13, 2015.
- 3.3 Registration closes at 1000 hours on Saturday, May 16, 2015.
- 3.4 All entry fees are nonrefundable.

4 Schedules

- 4.1 A competitors' meeting is scheduled for 1030 hours on Saturday, May 16, 2015 at the SCYC clubhouse.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1230 hours Saturday and 1200 hours Sunday.
- 4.3 Six races (6) are scheduled. Three races on Saturday and three races on Sunday.
- 4.4 Three (3) races will constitute a regatta.
- 4.5 No warning signal will be made after 1530 hours on Sunday May 17.
- 4.6 There will be an awards ceremony at the SCYC clubhouse on Sunday May 17 following racing.

5 Sailing Instructions

- 5.1 The sailing instructions will be available at the competitors' meeting and on line at scyc.org.

6 Venue

- 6.1 Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys and fixed buoys in the north end of Monterey Bay. The racing area will be within a three-mile radius of the Walton Lighthouse on the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

7 Courses

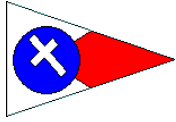
- 7.1 A course diagram will be provided in the sailing instructions.

8 Prizes

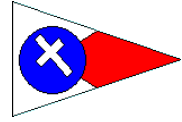
- 8.1 Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority.

Friday May 15th: Weigh in time between 1800 and 2000 at the SCYC race office.

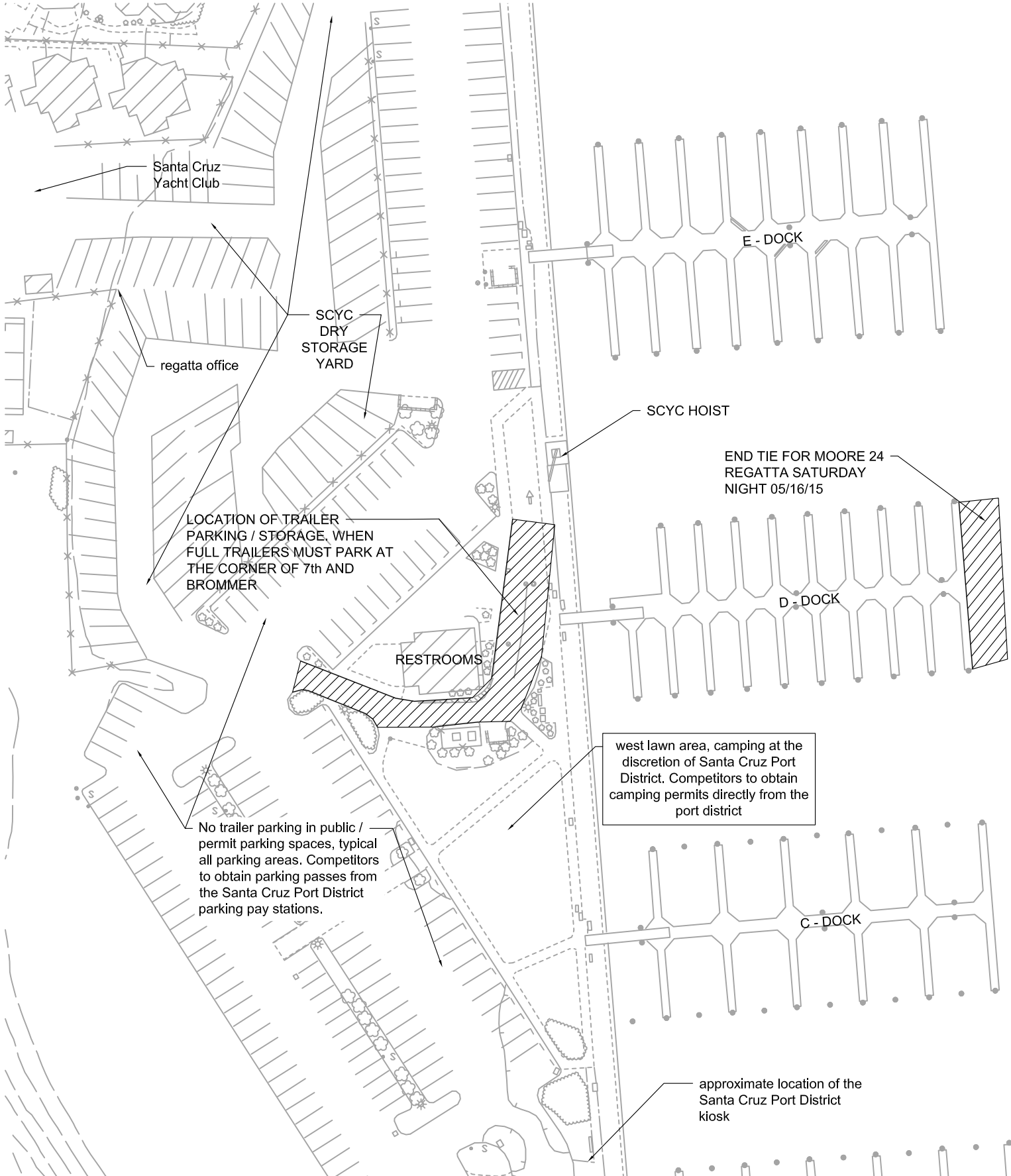
Saturday May 16th: Weigh in time between 1000 to 1100 at the SCYC race office
