Sailing Instructions

1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. Entries

Open to all boats with a valid Portsmouth rating. Competitors may enter by delivering a completed entry form and entry fee to the registration table in the Pavilion before 1100 on 30 May 2015.

3. Notices to Competitors

Notices to competitors will be posted on the chalkboard on the Northwestern corner of the Pavilion.

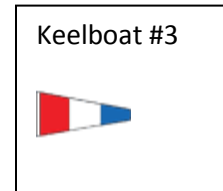
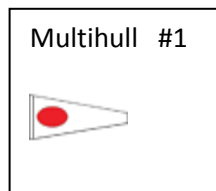
4. Signals Made Ashore

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the flagpole on the main dock. If a postponement is signaled ashore, the warning signal will be made not less than 30 minutes after flag AP is lowered.

6. Racing Area

The racing area will be on the Halifax River between the Memorial and Dunlawton Bridges.

7. Courses and Marks

The course and marks will be described during the competitors meeting.

8. Starting and Finishing Lines

The starting and finishing lines will be described during the competitors meeting.

9. Time Limit

The time limit for each class will be 2 hours after for the first boat in its class finishes.

10. Protests

Protests shall be delivered to the Pavilion within 30 minutes after the last boat finishes. The protest time limit and a list of protests received will be posted on the notice board. Hearings will be held in the Pavilion as soon as practicable after racing.

11. Scoring

There will be one race. Each boat's time will be corrected in accordance with the Portsmouth rating of that boat.

12. Awards

Awards will be given to the top three in each class: Multihull, Centerboard Dinghy and Keelboat.

13. Safety

The organizing authority requires that competitors wear life jackets and closed toed shoes when on the beach and when sailing. Safety boats will be on the water during racing.
