- 1.2 The fee is \$55.
 - Entries for boats requesting a courtesy PHRF rating must be received by 2000 hours on Friday, 14 August 2015.
 - Entries for boats with a valid PHRF certification must be received by 2000 hours on Thursday, 20 August 2015.

2 ELIGIBILITY

2.1 This race is open to boats of the following classes:

- 2.2 Additional one-design classes will be accepted upon the receipt of six (6) or more paid entries by 2000 hours on Wednesday, 19 August 2015.
- 2.3 PHRF N competitors may use double headsails.
- 2.4 One-design class rules will apply.

3 RULES

- 3.1 Racing shall be governed by the *rules* as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing*. RRS 63.7, Conflict between Rules, is replaced by, "*If there is a conflict between the Event Sailing Instructions and the Notice Of Race, the Event Sailing Instructions shall apply.*"
- 3.2 The Event Sailing Instructions will be available on the EYC website no later than Thursday, 06 August 2015, and posted on the Official Notice Board at the EYC clubhouse.

4.2 Rendezvous will be at 1100 hours in the vicinity of CBYRA Region 3 Annapolis Area mark **"X"** (Government mark R2, FL 2.5s) at the mouth of the Severn River.

5 VENUES & COURSES

- 5.1 The CRAB/Freedom 20, PHRF Spinnaker, PHRF N, Alerion 28 Express, and J/70 classes will sail one (1) pursuit-style race with a reverse-PHRF starting order using CBYRA Region 3 Annapolis Area standard racing marks. This modifies RRS 26.
- 5.2 The Harbor 20 class will sail one (1) Severn River race, started in accordance with RRS 26.

6 PRIZES

- 6.1 Prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Places will be awarded for the Overall finish positions in the pursuit race.
- 6.2 Special trophies for 1st through 4th Places will be awarded in the CRAB/Freedom 20 class.
- 6.3 Prizes in the PHRF Spinnaker, PHRF N, Alerion Express 28, Cal 25, Harbor 20, and J/70 classes will be as follows:

1st and 2nd Places for six (6) or more entries;

 3^{rd} Place for seven (7) or more entries.

- 6.4 The North Sails Fleet Award will be presented to the One-Design fleet with the greatest number of boats on the start line at the Boatyard Bar & Grill Race to Benefit CRAB.
- 6.5 The Spirit Trophy will be presented to the best-costumed crew across all competing classes.

7 INSURANCE

Each boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000.

8 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

This is a Clean Race; all competitors are encouraged not to use disposable water bottles. Racers should refrain from throwing trash in the water and recycle all appropriate items.
