1. RULES

The sailboat races will be governed by the 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the OCSA General Sailing Instructions which will be available Saturday, September 19th. SYSCO will administer the Race.

2. FLEETS

<u>PHRF:</u> Spinnaker and Non-spinnaker cruising. Class breaks will be defined by Saturday, September 18th Three valid entries are necessary to establish a class.

One Design: Three valid entries are necessary to establish a class.

3. RACE FORMAT & LOCATION

All sailboat racing will be conducted on custom courses with fixed or temporary marks on the Columbia River between the I-5 and 205 bridges. An after party will be held at Portland Yacht Club following the Regatta.

4. ELEGIBILITY

Competitors: This race is open to all. Competitors need not be a member of a Yacht Club. PHRF Sailboats: Participating PHRF boats must have a current PHRF certificate. Boats without a current PHRF certificate will be a assigned a temporary rating by the Race Committee equal to the rating for similar boats.

5. ENTRY FEES

Please register early for this worthy cause so that the event can be properly planned. The Entry Fees shown are the minimum amount required to participate in this event. Additional fundraising participation for this worthy cause is encouraged. Entry fee includes race, (1) personal fundraising website, entry for (1) to the Gosling Rum after party and t-shirt.
