Fleet 48 at Lake Norman Yacht Club, Mooresville, NC invites you to our annual Fall 48 Regatta located on North Carolina's largest lake. This year's theme is Thanksgiving Fall 48. This season ending event will focus on giving thanks for the supportive sailing community and friendships, the fair winds and the exciting on the water competition.

The ACC Regatta in New Bern was also going to serve as the Carolina's District Championship. The event was postponed by mother nature's fury. Many of you asked that we use the Fall 48 as a venue for the Carolina's District Championship, and we listened. The Fall 48 Regatta will now serve as the venue for the Carolina's District Championship. The Fall 48 is an open Regatta however to be eligible to compete for the Carolina's District Trophy, you must be a member of the Carolina's District.

The event was started 20 years ago as a season-ending 5-race no-frills, low cost event designed to draw many of the best sailors east of the Mississippi. Today you can expect expert race management, tough competition, great food, and an opportunity to strengthen your sailing friendships. In keeping with the Thanksgiving spirit, Fleet 48 is offering a special "thank you" rate of \$54 (combined regatta, breakfast and dinner fee for you and your crew). The Regatta kicks off on Friday with an on the water clinic with Brian Hayes and Bill Wiggins of North Sails.

- 1. Rules The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 2. **Eligibility and Crew** The regatta is open to all Flying Scots, and all competitors must be current members of the FSSA. You can join FSSA by going to <a href="www.fssa.com">www.fssa.com</a> or calling 800-445-8629.

- 5. **Sailing Instructions** Sailing instructions will be available at registration, and the NOR will be posted on the Official Notice Board on the lower level of the Race Management Center.
- 6. **Number of Races** A maximum of five races are scheduled, and one race must be completed to constitute the Fall 48 regatta.
- 7. Alternative Penalty Appendix T sections A&B in the R.R.S will be in effect
- 8. Courses Windward-Leeward (WL) or Modified Windward-Leeward (MWL).
- **8. Scoring** Will be according to the RRS Appendix A Low Point system. Each boat's score shall be the total of her race scores with no race excluded. This changes RRS A2.
- 9. **Safety** A boat retiring from a race shall notify a Race Committee vessel before leaving the course, or when that is impossible, as soon as possible after arrival ashore.
- 10. **Club Info** Camping at the club is free to everyone; however pets and open fires are not allowed. Please visit <a href="www.lnyc.org">www.lnyc.org</a> for directions.
- 11. Prizes Trophies will be awarded as follows:
  - a. Fall 48, 1<sup>st</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> places
- 12. **Registration** The options are:
  - a. Online **This allows you to pay by credit card.** Go to Regatta Network to register. You will need to sign the Release and Waiver on-site at the Registration table.
  - b. On-site See Event Schedule above for the times

- 13. **RADIO COMMUNICATION VHF** radios may be carried aboard. As a courtesy, the Race Committee will provide information to competitors on an as needed basis. After the starting signal, the Race Committee will attempt to hail boats (including by VHF radio) that are OCS and boats that have not complied with RRS 30.1. The delay of such hails, the order of hailing, the lack of a hail, or failure of a competitor to hear such a hail shall not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a)
