1. RULES

The Race will be governed by the current international sailing foundation Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the GYA Regulations for Sanctioned Event, apply to the Weatherly Regatta and The Leukemia Cup Regatta Sailing Instructions, which will be available at the Skippers' Meeting. Gulfport Yacht Club (GYC) will administer the Race.

2. CLASSES

PHRF: Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker and Multi-Hull; class breaks will be defined at the Skippers' Meeting.

One Design Classes: Specific classes to be determined by entries; three valid entries are necessary to establish a class; Optimists will be included.

3. RACE FORMAT & LOCATION

All racing will be conducted on custom courses with fixed or temporary marks on the Mississippi Sound southeast of Gulfport Small Craft Harbor.

4. ADVERTISING

The regatta is designated Category A in accordance ISAF Regulation 20 for all classes. Racers may upgrade to Category C which allows advertising if their boat raises \$250 or more; there will be no additional entry fee for Category C.

5. ELIGIBILITY

Competitors: The Leukemia Cup Regatta is open to all. Competitors need not be a member of a yacht club.

Boat: PHRF boats must have a current GYA PHRF certificate. Boats without a current GYA PHRF certificate will be assigned a rating based upon similar boats. The assigned rating cannot be protested.

6. ENTRY FEES

For all classes other than the Capdeville Class the entry fee is \$35. Please register early for this worthy cause so that the event can be properly planned. The entry fees shown are the minimum amount required to participate in the event. Additional donations for this worthy cause are encouraged and will be recognized.
