NOTICE OF RACE including Amendment #1

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Boats racing in PHRF must have a valid 4P rating issued by PHRF/Chesapeake.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats will not be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 There will be 3 fleets for this regatta.
- 3.2 Classes eligible for Fleet 1 are: J/70, J/80, J/22, PHRF B, & PHRF C.
- 3.3 Classes eligible for Fleet 2 are: J/30, J/35, J/105, PHRF A0, PHRF A1, & PHRF A2.
- 3.4 Classes eligible for Fleet 3 are: PHRF N, CBYRA Multihull A and B.

4 CLASSIFICATION

There will be no sailor classification requirements beyond those stated in applicable class rules.

5 FEES AND ENTRY

- 5.1 The entry fees are:
 - PHRF A0 - \$180
 - PHRF A1 - \$145
 - PHRF A2 and J/35 - \$140
 - PHRF B, J/105, J/70, J/80, J/30, and J/22 - \$125
 - PHRF C - \$110
 - PHRF N and Multihull - \$50
- 5.2 Boats wishing to enter shall register on line at www.annapolisyc.com/racing.
- 5.3 Registrations made after 1900 on 22 September 2015 will be subject to a \$25 late fee. Entry fees are due in full by 1900 on 29 September 2015 and are non-refundable.
- 5.4 To be considered an entry, a boat must complete all requirements of registration.
- 5.5 The fee includes all racing and skipper and crew admission to the party at AYC each day of racing.

6 SCHEDULE

6.2 Six races, including the distance race are scheduled for Fleets 1 and 2. One race is scheduled for fleet 3.

7 MEASUREMENT AND INSPECTION

No pre-regatta measurements or inspections will be required.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available at the AYC Front Desk and will be posted on the event website by 1900 on Thursday, 1 October 2015.

9 VENUE

9.1 Attachment 1 shows the layout of the regatta venue.

9.2 Attachment 2 shows the location of the racing area.

10 THE COURSES

10.1 The courses to be sailed on 3 & 4 October and 17 & 18 October will be windward-leeward drop mark courses.

10.2 The courses to be sailed on 10 October will be a distance races as shown in the AYC Event Sailing Instructions and will be designed to provide 3 to 6 hours of racing. They will be based on a combination of the CBYRA Region 3 Standard Racing Marks.

11 PENALTY SYSTEM

11.1 Penalties while racing: RRS 44.1, One-Turn and Two-Turns Penalties will apply.

11.2 Penalties after racing: RRS/US Appendix T, Section B (Post-Race Penalties) will apply.

12 SCORING

12.1 RRS Appendix A4, Low Point System, will apply.

12.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

12.3 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores for the drop mark races plus 1.5 times her race score for the distance race.

13 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

There will be no restrictions on haul-out.

14 RADIO COMMUNICATION

The race committee intends to make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The specific channel will be stated in the sailing instructions.

15 PRIZES

15.1 Prizes will be given as follows: for 3 or more entrants: 1st place
for 5 or more entrants: 2nd place
for 7 or more entrants: 3rd place

15.2 Perpetual trophies and other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

15.3 Prizes will be awarded at the AYC Annual Awards Ceremony on Saturday 21 November, 2015

16 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

17 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$US 300,000 per event or the equivalent.
