2. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the ICSA Procedural Rules (2013 - 2016), the ISSA Procedural Rules (as modified by the PCISA or PCCSC), the 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US SAILING (US Sailing prescriptions to rules 60, 63.2, 63.4 are deleted); the rules of the Laser/Radial Class (except as altered by the Sailing Instructions, or the ICSA/ISSA/PCISA, PCCSC Procedural Rules); and by the Sailing Instructions. In accordance with ICSA and ISSA Procedural Rules PR38(c) and PR20(b) respectively the right of appeal is denied at all Conference/District Championships. Decisions of the Protest Committee shall be final.

3. FORMAT & ELIGIBILITY

College Fleets

Up to 4 Competitors per division (Male-Laser Full Rig and Female-Radial) may enter from each PCCSC member school previously approved by the PCCSC Conference Commissioner.

High School Fleets

High School will be sailed in two fleets Full Rig and Radial. Properly registered (2015-16 ISSA/PCISA) teams may enter as many eligible competitors in each fleet as desired. Boys and girls may enter and compete in either fleet.

ALL fleets will sail separately (Course A- College Full Rig then High School Radial – Course B - High School Full Rigs then College Women CFJ's). See separate Notice of Race for College Women CFJ's.

4. BOATS & SAILS

Each team entered is responsible for providing one complete class legal Laser/Radial for each competitor. Competitors will sail the same boat for the entire regatta. No boat rotations.

6. SKIPPERS' MEETING, SAILING INSTRUCTIONS & CHECK IN

All teams must check in at the registration table on the beach near the Belmont Pier first thing Saturday morning (Friday morning for College Women). There will be a skippers' meeting at 10:30 a.m. on Saturday, September 26th (Friday Sept. 25th for College Women) near the registration table on the beach. Sailing Instructions will be available at the check in table. Check in will begin at 0830 (0900 on Friday for College Women).

7. ENTRY

The online entry form must be completed by 5pm (PDT) on September 18, 2015. Entry fees must be paid in full with the online entry and by the deadline. It is highly likely that late entries will not be accepted. Access the online entry system via: www.uscsailing.org; www.ussclb.org; pccsc.collegesailing.org or www.pcisa.org.

8. ENTRY FEES

Entry Fees are \$35.00 per competitor (College or H.S.) and they are due with online registration by 5pm on September 18, 2015. If a late entry is allowed the fee will be \$50.00 for entry registrations or entry fee payments made after September 18, 2015.

9. SAILING AREA/LAUNCHING

The sailing area for all fleets will be in the Long Beach Harbor next to the Belmont Memorial Pier. There will be two race courses (Saturday & Sunday – Only One on Friday) – One for College Full Rig & High School Radials and One for High School Full Rigs and College Women CFJs. From noon Friday, January 2nd until dark on Sunday, January 4th, trailers can be parked in the parking lot at the Belmont Memorial Pier (at the end of Termino Ave.) and boats can be kept on dollies on the beach. There will be security at the beach after dark on Friday and Saturday nights.

10. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded to teams/competitors qualifying for ICSA and ISSA Single-handed Nationals. This is: Top 2 Finishers in College Men's and College Women's Top 3 Finishers in High School Full Rig and Radials

11. T - SHIRTS

T – Shirts may be available at \$14.00 each when **pre-ordered**, and **prepaid** by **September 18**th **via the online registration**. T-shirts may also be sold at the event at a higher price.

12. HOUSING
