IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR COACH AND PARENT BOATS

Lowdermilk Park:

All cars associated with the regatta should display a parking pass on the front dash. Cars failing to display the parking pass may be subject to ticketing by the City of Naples Police Department. Parking passes are available at the registration tent. Park rules prohibit motor homes, overnight parking, camping, alcohol and glass containers.

Special arrangements have been made for off-site coach and spectator boat trailer parking. Boat and trailer parking in the general parking lot at Lowdermilk is prohibited and violators will be subject to ticketing.

Directions From Lowdermilk Park to City Boat Ramp:

Leaving Lowdermilk Park, turn right (south) on Gulfshore Blvd. and continue until 10th Avenue South. Turn left (east) on 10th Avenue South and continue to the traffic signal on 9th Street. Turn right (south) on 9th Street. The City of Naples boat ramp, "The Landings" is 50 yards ahead on your left. While traveling through Naples Bay and Gordon Pass, remember to observe all "No Wake" signs.

Directions from City Boat Ramp to Trailer Parking Lot

Leaving the boat ramp, turn right (north) on 9th Street and proceed north to the traffic signal at 6th Avenue South. Turn right (east) on 6th Avenue South and proceed approx. 50 yards to a vacant paved lot on the south side of 6th Avenue South. Look for Naples Cup signs. Please park your trailer such that we maximize the number of trailers that can be accommodated. Do not leave any trash on this site. The owner kindly donates this site and we appreciate his support of youth sailing.

Directions from Trailer Parking Back to Lowdermilk Park

When you leave the lot, turn left (north) back to 9th Street and continue north to 7th Avenue North. Turn left (west) on 7th Avenue North and continue west to Gulf Shore Blvd. Turn right (north) on Gulf Shore Blvd. and proceed back to Lowdermilk Park.

IMPORTANT!!

Dockage on Saturday Night:

Coach Boats: Coach boats only have permission to use the docks at Beacon House, located inside Doctor's Pass. Separate instructions regarding coach boat registration will be provided.

Parent / Support Boats: Parent and support boats have two options:

- 1. Return the City ramp and trailer your boat to the Trailer Parking Lot described above for overnight storage or trailer your boat back to your hotel;
- 2. Tie up at the NCSC aluminum dock. The raft-up may not be more than three boats deep. NO BOATS MAY BE TIED TO OR OBSTRUCT THE WOOD DOCK!!! Please remove all trash from the area.

PLEASE REMEMBER ALL EQUIPMENT LEFT AT LOWDERMILK PARK, THE TRAILER LOT AND THE NCSC DOCK IS LEFT AT THE OWNER'S RISK.
