FACTS FOUND

- 1. On the first windward leg with wind between 15 and 18 knots USA 1265 and NED 1518 were sailing on port tack with USA 1265 3 boat lengths ahead and to leeward of NED 1518
- 2. USA 1265 tacked to starboard and after getting on to close hauled course, lost control of the boat and heeled excessively to leeward.
- 3. NED 1518 started to bear away but there was a contact with damage between the mast head of USA 1265 and the mainsail of NED 1518

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. The equipment of USA 1265 was unexpectedly out of normal position, therefore NED 1518 did not break rule 10 (see World Sailing case 77)
- 2. USA 1265 broke rule 14 by not avoiding contact.
- 3. It was not reasonably possible for NED 1518 to avoid contact therefore she did not break rule 14.
