FACTS FOUND

- 1. DEN 2375 and ARG 1888 were sailing on starboard with DEN 2375 clear ahead of ARG 1888 on a collision course
- 2. There was a collision between the bow of ARG 1888 and the transom of DEN 2375 causing damage with delamination to the transom of DEN 2375.
- 3. DEN 2375 was able to continue sailing and performance was not affected by the damage.
- 4. ARG 1888 took a penalty turn
- 5. The estimated cost of the repair is 400 Euros.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

ARG 1888 clear astern failed to keep clear of DEN 2375 and broke RRS 12

ARG 1888 broke RRS 14 by not avoiding contact

It was not reasonably possible for DEN 2375 to avoid contact and did not break rule 14.

ARG 1888 took a proper penalty under RRS 44.1

DECISION - Protest Upheld

No further penalties for ARG 1888 under RRS 64.1(b)
