FACTS FOUND

- 1. GBR 2025 was sailing towards the last mark before finishing race F4.
- 2. When GBR 2025 reached the zone, ITA 1738 and GER 1893 were clear astern of her.
- 3. ITA 1738 was clear astern of GER 1893 when reaching the zone.
- 4. When rounding the mark, there was a contact between the stern of GBR 2025 and the bowsprit of ITA 1738.
- 5. There was additional contact between the stern of GBR 2025 and the bowsprit of GER 1893, and between ITA 1738 and GER 1893.
- 6. No damage or injury occurred.
- 7. ITA completed a One-Turn Penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. ITA 1738 and GER 1893 failed to give mark room to GBR 2025 and broke RRS 18.2(b).
- 2. By not avoiding contact, ITA 1738 and GER 1893 also broke RRS 14.
- 3. It was not reasonably possible for GBR 2025 to avoid the contacts, therefore she did not break RRS 14.
- 4. ITA 1738 took an appropriate penalty under RRS 44.

DECISION - Protest Upheld

GER 1893 is disqualified (DSQ) in race F4.
