FACTS FOUND

- 1. A few minutes after the start of race F8, HKG 2521 was sailing on starboard, SWE 1670 was sailing on port tack.
- 2. There were light wind conditions.
- 3. HKG 2521 tacked in front of SWE 1670.
- 4. Two seconds after HKG 2521 reached close-hauled course on port tack, there was a contact between the bow of SWE 1670 and the transom of HKG 2521.
- 5. The contact caused a 4 cm long crack on the port side of the transom of HKG 2521.
- 6. No penalty was taken.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. After acquiring right-of-way, HKG 2521 failed to initially give SWE 1670 room to keep clear and broke RRS 15.
- 2. By not avoiding contact, HKG 2521 also broke RRS 14.
- 3. It was not reasonably possible for SWE 1670 to avoid contact, therefore she did not break RRS 14.

DECISION - Protest Upheld

HKG 2521 is disqualified (DSQ) in race F8.
