## **NOTICE OF RACE**

#### 1. Rules

- 1.1 This regatta is governed by the US Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The organizing authority is the Flying Scot Sailing Association
- 1.3 The event will be held on the waters of the Chesapeake Bay at the mouth of the Piankatank River or in Fishing Bay.

### 2. Eligibility and Entry

2.1 The regatta is open to Active, Life, Junior, Club and Family Members of the FSSA. The FSSA handbook defines each category. The crew shall consist only of a helmsman and his/her spouse; the helmsman may be switched during the series as best suits each crew (this is an exception to Article B – VIII-6a). Either spouse may be the required Active, Life, Club, or Family Member. Perpetual Trophies include:

Ted and Florence Glass Trophy
1st Championship Division

Cal and Anita Hudson Trophy
1st Challenger Division

Eric and Mary Amman Trophy

Best finish by wife/husband whose combined age equals or exceeds 100.

- 2.2 All Co-Owners shall comply with requirements as stated in By-Laws Para. B VIII 6 d.
- 2.3 All entries must be received by 0930, June 11.

- 4.2 No race will start after 1330 on Sunday. Awards to follow.
- 4.3 Five races are scheduled for the Championship Division. Three races are scheduled for the Challenger Division. The Challenger Division shall race no more than two races per day.
- 4.4 Competitors must declare their division prior to the end of registration.
- 4.5 One race completed will constitute the regatta.
- 5. Sailing Instructions, VHFs and Courses
  - 5.1 Sailing Instructions will be available during on-site registration
  - 5.2 VHF radios will be allowed.
  - 5.3 Courses to be sailed will be in the Sailing Instructions and indicated on the RC Signal Boat in the racing area.
- 6. Scoring:
  - 6.1 The Low Point Scoring System but no scores will be excluded. This changes RS A2.
- 7. Awards:
  - 7.1 Trophies will be awarded for first, second, and third place in each fleet.
