

Sailing Instructions – Amendment 1

Los Angeles Yacht Club 2016 George Griffith Series March 26 April 2 - May 7 AMENDMENT 1

The Sailing Instructions, as they apply to Race 2 and Race 3 of the George Griffith Series, are hereby amended by deleting Sections 3.1, 7.3, 7.4, 7.6 and 9.1 and substituting in their stead the following:

3. CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Any change to The Sailing Instructions or other race related documents will be posted before 1000 hours on the day of the race it will affect.

7. THE START

- 7.3 Starting times will be staggered according to assigned PHRF handicaps. A list of starting times will be available no later than 1900 on the Friday prior to the start of each race.
- 7.4 To alert everyone that a starting sequence is about to commence, multiple sound signals will be made approximately one minute before the warning signal.

7.6 Beginning at 1310, a horn will sound at 10 minute intervals, accompanied by the Numeral Pennant on the stern of the RC boat as follows: "1" at 1310, "2" at 1320, "3" at 1330, etc. These flags will be lowered 1 minute prior to the next flag.

9. TIME LIMIT

9.1 Boats finishing after 1700 hours shall be scored DNF. This changes RRS 35 and A4.
