Rules: The regatta will be governed by: 1) the *Racing Rules of Sailing for 2013–2016* (RRS), 2) the Notice of Race, 3) the CBYRA Green Book General Sailing Instructions (GSI), 4), and these Event Sailing Instructions.

Notices to

Competitors: Notices to competitors will be posted on the Shearwater Sailing Club website (www.shearwatersc.net) no later than 1700, Friday, 17 June 2016. This changes GSI 2.1.

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 71 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

Rendezvous: At 1600 in vicinity of Severn River R"2" (Region 3 Annapolis Area Mark "X").

Start: Between yellow or orange flag on Race Committee boat and nearby inflatable or government mark. The first warning signal is scheduled for 1700. The planned starting sequence is as follows:

* Yachts in classes having few entries may be combined for scoring with other classes for the purpose of giving extra awards at the discretion of the race committee

Course: Annapolis Area Region 3 standard racing marks as designated by letters displayed on Race Committee boat.

Finish: Between yellow or orange flag on Race Committee boat and last mark of course.

Time Limit: Midnight for all classes. Boats not finishing within one hour of the first boat in their class to finish will be scored TLE and awarded points equal to the number of finishers plus two, but in no case more than the number of starters. This changes RRS 35 and A4.1.

Protests: Mail to SSC Race Committee, at address above, postmarked no later than Monday 20 June 2016. Hearing at a time and place to be announced.

Awards: 1st/3, 2nd/5, 3rd/7 & 4th/10+ starters. Yachts in classes having few entries may be combined for scoring with other classes for the purpose of giving extra awards at the discretion of the race committee. Trophies may be mailed or presented at a Shearwater Sailing Club event.

Other: IMPERATIVE: Each yacht is responsible for following the *CBYRA General Sailing Instructions* for racing and finishing at night.
