NOTICE OF RACE

Subject to Amendment

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016 (RRS).
- 1.2 The class rules of the participating classes will apply. Boats in the 420 class may use any recognized 420 hull form with the standard club training rig (with non-tapered mast) and shall have a minimum weight of 100 kg fully rigged for sailing and in dry condition but without sails and personal equipment.
- 1.3 RRS G1.1(b) will not apply.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising will be permitted under Category C in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.

3 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats in the following classes: Laser Standard, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7; Optimist Green Fleet, Championship Fleet; Open Bic (under 16 yrs old); Club 420; IC24
- 3.2 Two boats will constitute a class.

4 FEES

- 4.1 Required entry fees are as follows:
 - 4.1.1 Optimist Championship, Optimist Green \$75
 - 4.1.2 Open Bic: \$75
 - 4.1.3 Laser Standard, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7: \$75
 - 4.1.4 Club 420: \$120
 - 4.1.5 IC-24: \$175
- 4.2 This entry fee does not include equipment hire.
- 4.3 Boats and equipment will be available for hire and must be booked through the RBVIYC no later than 14 days prior to the event.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Registration: Friday 20 May 2016 from 16:00-18:00 at the RBVIYC Youth Sailing Program Centre at Nanny Cay.
Late registration: 08:00-08:30 on Saturday 21 May at the Youth Sailing Centre.
- 5.2 Competitor and Coaches Meeting: Saturday 21 May at 09:00 at Nanny Cay on the Wooden Deck by the Beach.
Green fleet racers will have a separate meeting after the main competitors meeting.
- 5.3 Dates of racing: Saturday 21 and Sunday 22 May 2016 - all classes.

- 5.4 Number of races: There is no maximum number of races.
- 5.5 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 10:00 on 21 May and 09:00 on 22 May. No race will be started after 14:00 on 22 May.
- 5.6 The Awards Ceremony will take place at Nanny Cay on the Wooden Deck by the beach as soon as all racing/protests/hearings are concluded.
- 6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**
- 6.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available during registration. Extra copies will be made available.
- 7 VENUE**
- 7.1 Racing will take place in the Sir Francis Drake Channel adjacent to Nanny Cay, Tortola.
- 8 COURSE**
- 8.1 The course(s) will be announced in the Sailing Instructions.
- 9 PENALTY SYSTEM**
- 9.1 For all classes rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.
- 10 SCORING**
- 10.1 The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.
- 11 SUPPORT BOATS AND COACH BOATS**
- 11.1 In a general emergency situation, all Support and Coach Boats shall be utilized as safety boats and shall be under the direction of the Race Committee.
- 12 RADIO COMMUNICATION**
- 12.1 A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones and other devices.

- 14 PRIZES**
- 14.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 finishers in each class/class division.
- 15 CODE OF CONDUCT/SAFETY REGULATIONS**
- 15.1 Competitors, Parents, and Coaches will comply with the Code of Conduct for guests of the RBVIYC.
- 15.2 Competitors under the age of 18 shall wear personal floatation devices at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment.
- 16 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**
- 16.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

- 17.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance or the equivalent.
