### Notice of Race

March 18-20, 2016

#### 1. Organizing Authority

The organizing authority is the Sarasota Sailing Squadron.

#### 2. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) for 2013-2016 and applicable One Design Class Rules.

#### 3. Eligibility

The regatta is open to all one design classes with five (5) or more entries. Expected classes include but are not limited to Flying Scot, S2 7.9, E Scows, MC Scows, Albacore, Daysailers, Windmill and Windsurfers.

#### 4. Registration and Fees

- 4.1. 3-day racing: \$95.00 per boat; includes 2 Friday Dinner Tickets, 2 Saturday Dinner Tickets & 1 T-Shirt (open to Albacore, Daysailer, S2 7.9 – other classes may be added to 3 days of racing)
- 4.2. 2-day racing: \$75.00 per boat; includes 2 Saturday Dinner Tickets & 1 T-Shirt
- 4.3. \$30 Late Fee for paid registrations received after midnight on March 4, 2016.
- 4.4. Extra Dinner Tickets are \$15.00 for Friday and \$20.00 for Saturday.

#### 6. Sailing Instructions

#### 7. Race Area

Racing will be in Sarasota Bay.

#### 8. Scoring

- 8.1 One race will constitute a regatta.
- 8.2 When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes RRS A2.

#### 9. Prizes

Awards will be given out according to the number of registrants in each class and will be at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

#### 10. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in a regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

#### 11. Parking

The Sarasota Sailing Squadron is a very active sailing club. Parking is available for trailers and cars outside of the main entrance. Any cars/trailers parked inside the club blocking a member's boat/trailer will be towed at the owner's expense.

#### 12. Accommodations
